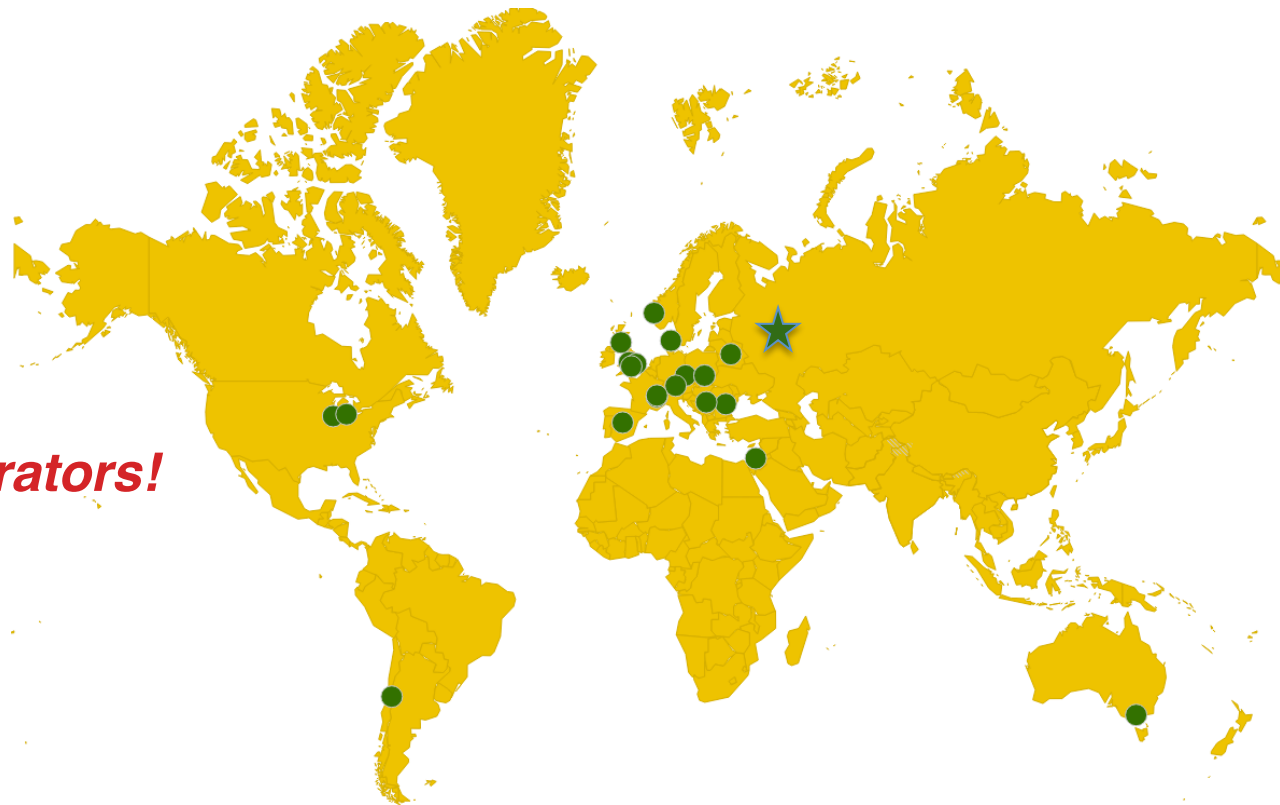
New member: JINR Dubna

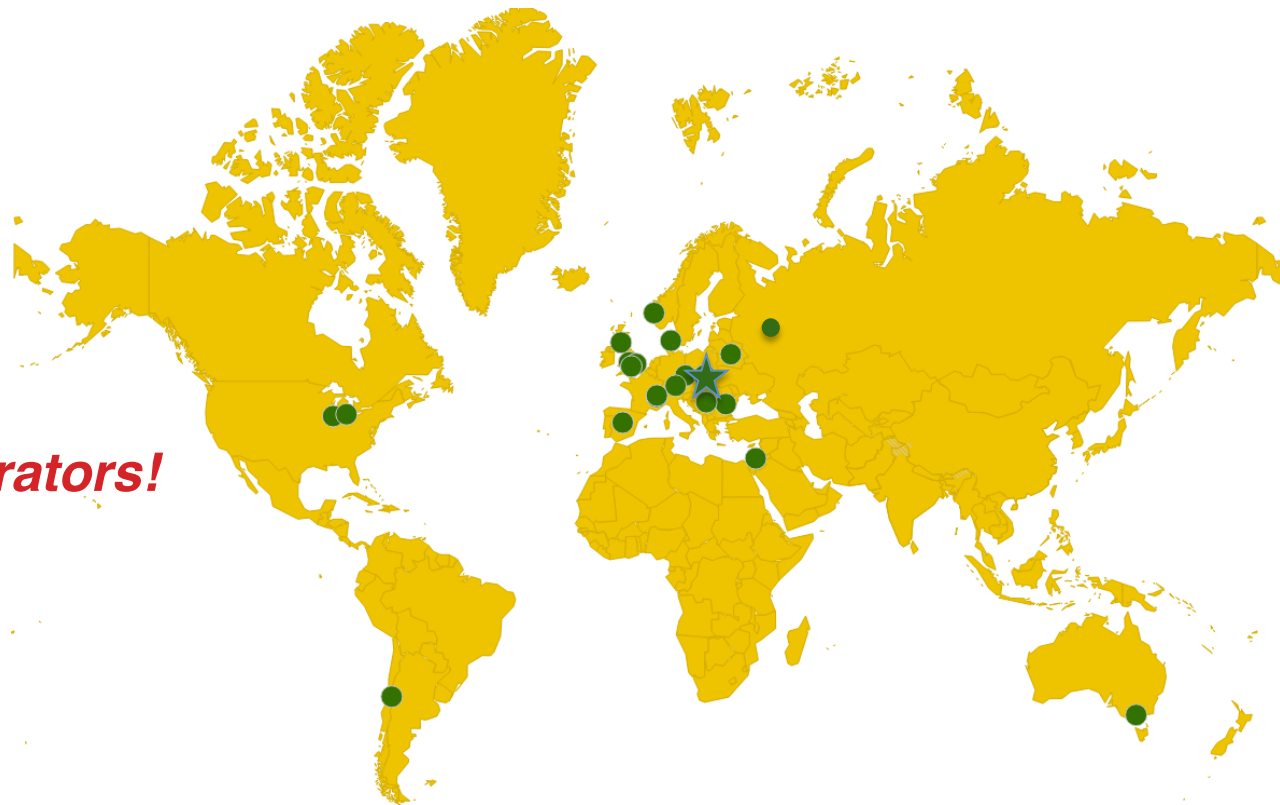
New member: University of Warsaw
