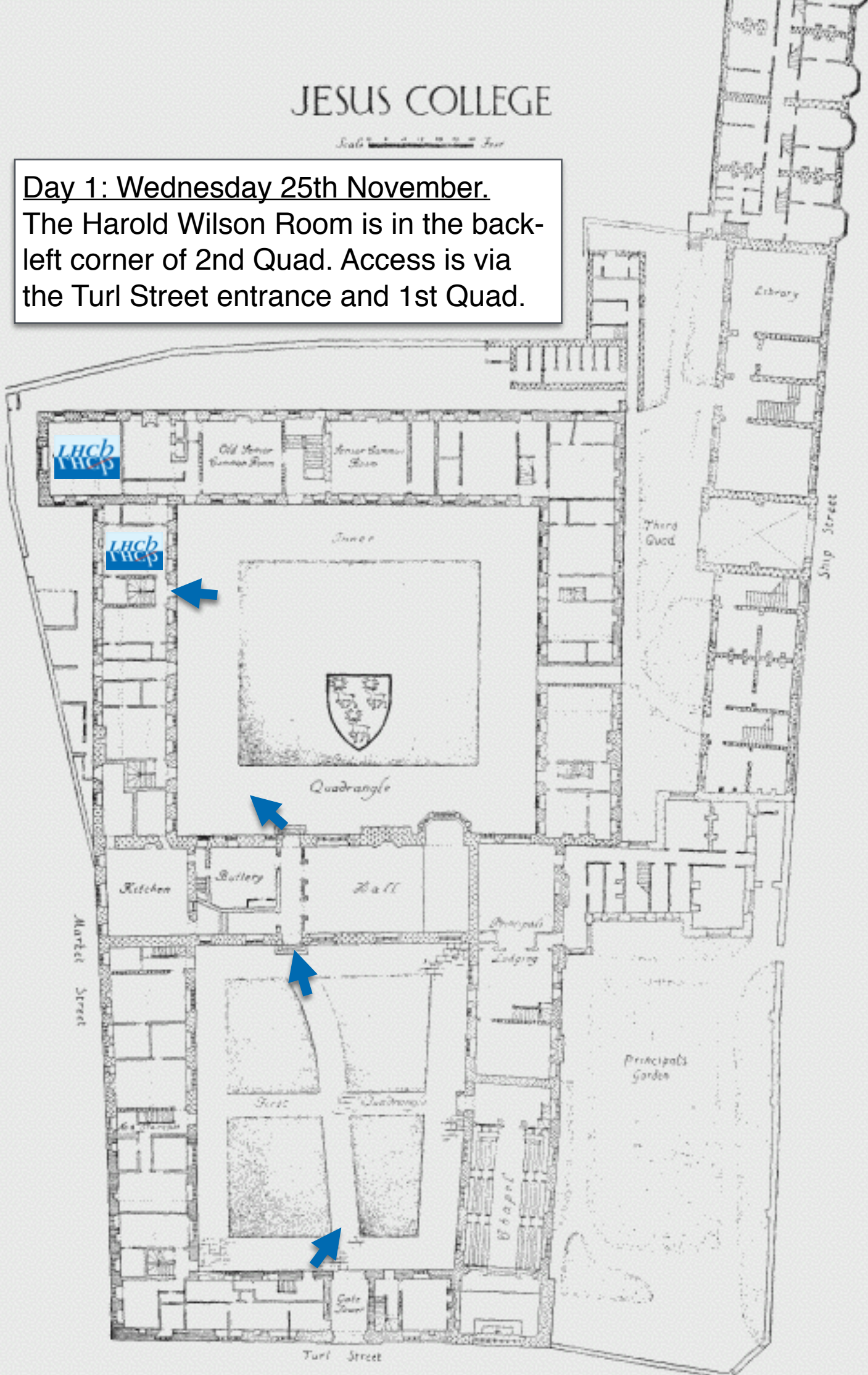

# JESUS COLLEGE

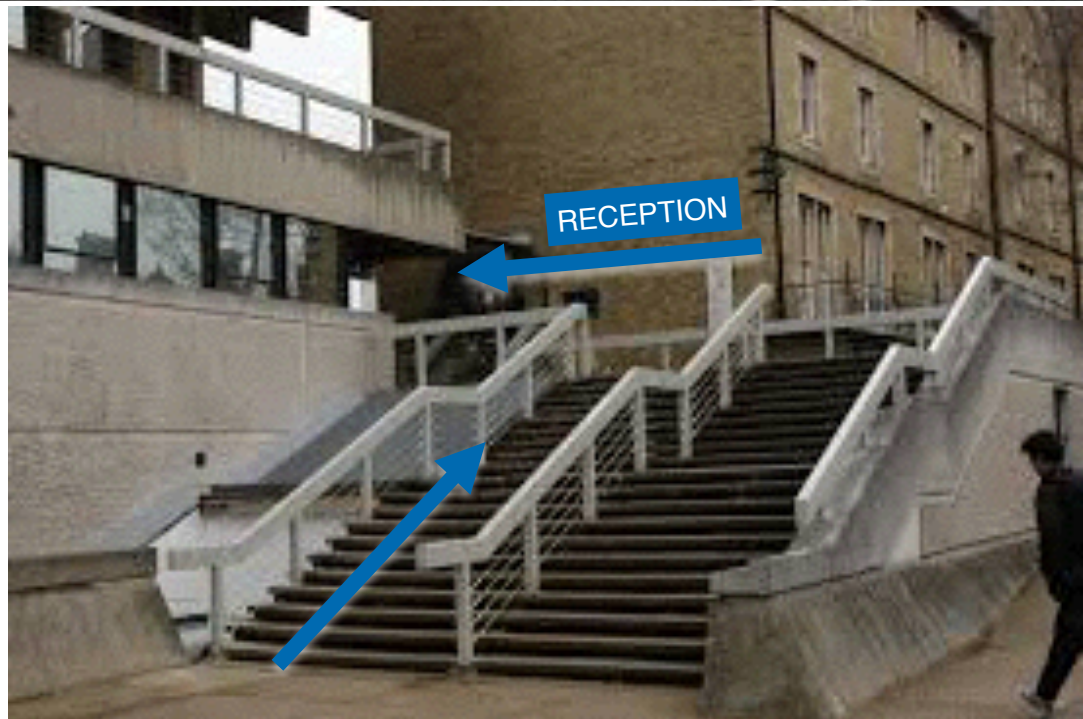
Scale 1" = 10' 0"

# Denys Wilkinson Building



Day 2: Thursday 26th November.

The conference room is on level 5 of the Denys Wilkinson Building, one level above the reception (walkway level).

## Transfers

Transport to and from Gatwick and Heathrow is simplest on The Airline express bus service to/from Gloucester Green Bus Station.

Buses to/from Heathrow are every 30 minutes and take maximum 1h45m (1h30m typical). Afternoon departures:

13:00 13:30 14:00 14:30 15:00 15:30 16:00 16:30

Buses to/from Gatwick are every hour and take maximum 2h45m (2h20m typical). Afternoon departures:

13:15 14:15 15:15 16:15

Return tickets (£29-£37) can be bought from the driver with cash only.



Tip: An efficient way to get to the hotel from The Airline is to arrange a taxi to meet you at the first (of several) stop in Oxford; at “Thornhill Park & Ride”
