

#### New CERN Department Structure

- IT/CO (Controls, collaborates with us on magnet controls, gas controls, ...) → merged with sections from AB/CO to a new group EN/ICE
- TS/DEM (PCB, GEM, MicroMegas)  $\rightarrow$  section in group EN/ICE
- TS/SU (Large scale survey, incl. experiments section C. Lasseur) → section in AB/ABP (beam physics group).
- TS/LEA (exp. area management, gas supply, ...)  $\rightarrow$  merged with others to EN/TC group
