Enabling Grids for E-sciencE

Each year (frequency?) EGI will hold a user conference (Cal)

- What should the structure/format be?
 - Focus (user-oriented) is the same. Leave as more relaxed. Expanding (naturally). What happens with supercomputing? Alternate co-location/separate events for prace. Keep current time table (spring).
- Who selects/nominates the venue?
 - Continue to use bidding process. Probably co-committee from UFSC evaluates—decision back to council.
- Who selects/elects/nominates the chair?
 - Technical chair always EGI.org. Honorary chair selected. User Forum SC selects theme and honorary chair.
- Who runs the registration?
 - EGI.org takes responsibility for the tools, maintenance; probably outsourced.
- Who makes the announcements?
 - EGI dissemination people make/provide materials.
- Who contacts the media?
 - EGI dissemination people. Others send material out locally.
- Who decides the programme?
 - UFSC decides the program committee, scope, etc.
- Who controls the budget?
 - Host takes financial responsibility. Keep event self-financed. Sponsors at least 1 year before. EC is completely funding right now.
- Co-location policy?
 - Completely changes event. Politically attractive, but not so much technically. EGI conference can do co-location with OGF.
- Transition:
 - Already try UF5 to do combined events. Spring 2010 tests model (model by end of march). Person needs to be in place well in advance.
- Proceedings:
 - Much more effort to do this. BOA or something needs to be available.



Flow/People

- Technical chair (EGI.org).
- UFSC proposes honorary chair/program committee.
- Dissemination "officer" inside EGI.org.
- Host for each event. (UFSC/EGI Council)

 Logistical support (tools) provided by EGI.org (probably outsourced).



Important Points

Statements:

- UF focus should remain the same; user-focused, relaxed.
- Scope naturally expands with MW/communities supported.
- UFSC at the center of the process.
- Event continues to be self-financed.

Recommend:

UF5 (2010) already uses EGI model.

Issues:

- Need EGI.org personnel in place well in advance.
- Model needs to be decided by end of March 2009.
- Abstracts/papers and BoA/proceedings. (Much more effort for proceedings.)
- Co-location policy. (Alternate co-location, e.g. with PRACE).
