

Some notes/things to look for for when I get to using OPERA!

Put the 'comi' files in a folder. Then using the OPERA manager go to that folder. Set the folder as a 2D Project folder.

This makes that folder a working folder.

You can open/edit the comi file with notepad++. These are scripts which set up the geometry and sets up the post processing. There is also on on screen editor which allows you to change everything on the fly.

To make a script right click on the side on window preference to open up a command line.

Three stages in FEM code

Pre-processing- set up geometry and material properties.

Execute the FEM solver

Post-processing to see what you have got.
