

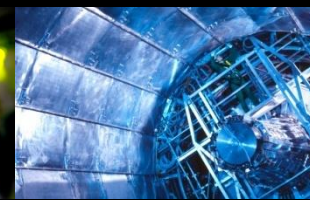
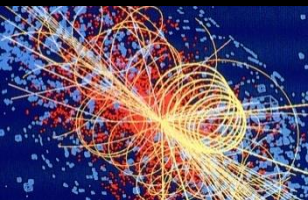

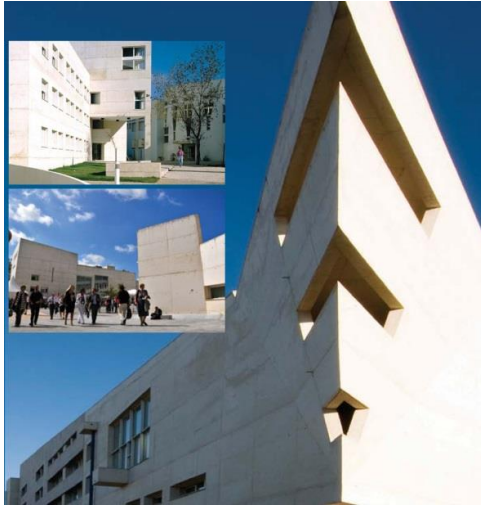
Motivations

 - **Monitoring, Information System and Accounting**
 - Information system evolution, cloud integration, accounting and benchmarking on clouds, network monitoring, SAM, ...
