



Earth's temporary natural satellites

- A constant population of natural bodies (=asteroids) on a geocentric orbit (Granvik et al. 2012)
- One confirmed TCO detected so far, 2006 RH₁₂₀ (Kwiatkowski et al. 2009)
- NES are formidable asteroid mission targets – low Δv and a rather long opportunity window
- NES are well suited for probing the lower end of asteroid size distribution.
