

CALOR 2018 in Eugene, Oregon

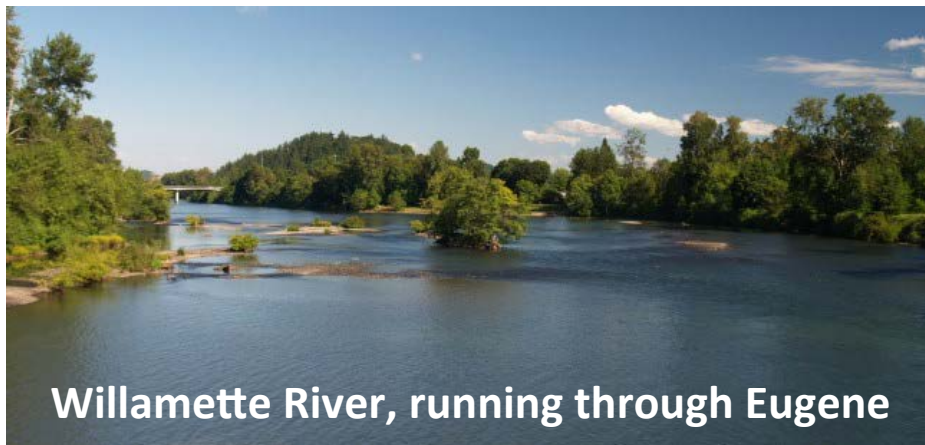
Tentative dates: Late June, 2018

Travel to Eugene, Oregon

There are two main options for travel to Eugene:

Direct flights from major US cities to Eugene Mahlon Sweet Airport

Good shuttle transportation from Eugene Airport to workshop venue

International flights to Portland and rental car from Portland to Eugene

Eugene is 120 miles from Portland International Airport on the Interstate highway, I-5, about 2 hours drive.

Portland Connections: Direct flight cities are in red, connecting flights in blue.



Travel to Eugene, Oregon

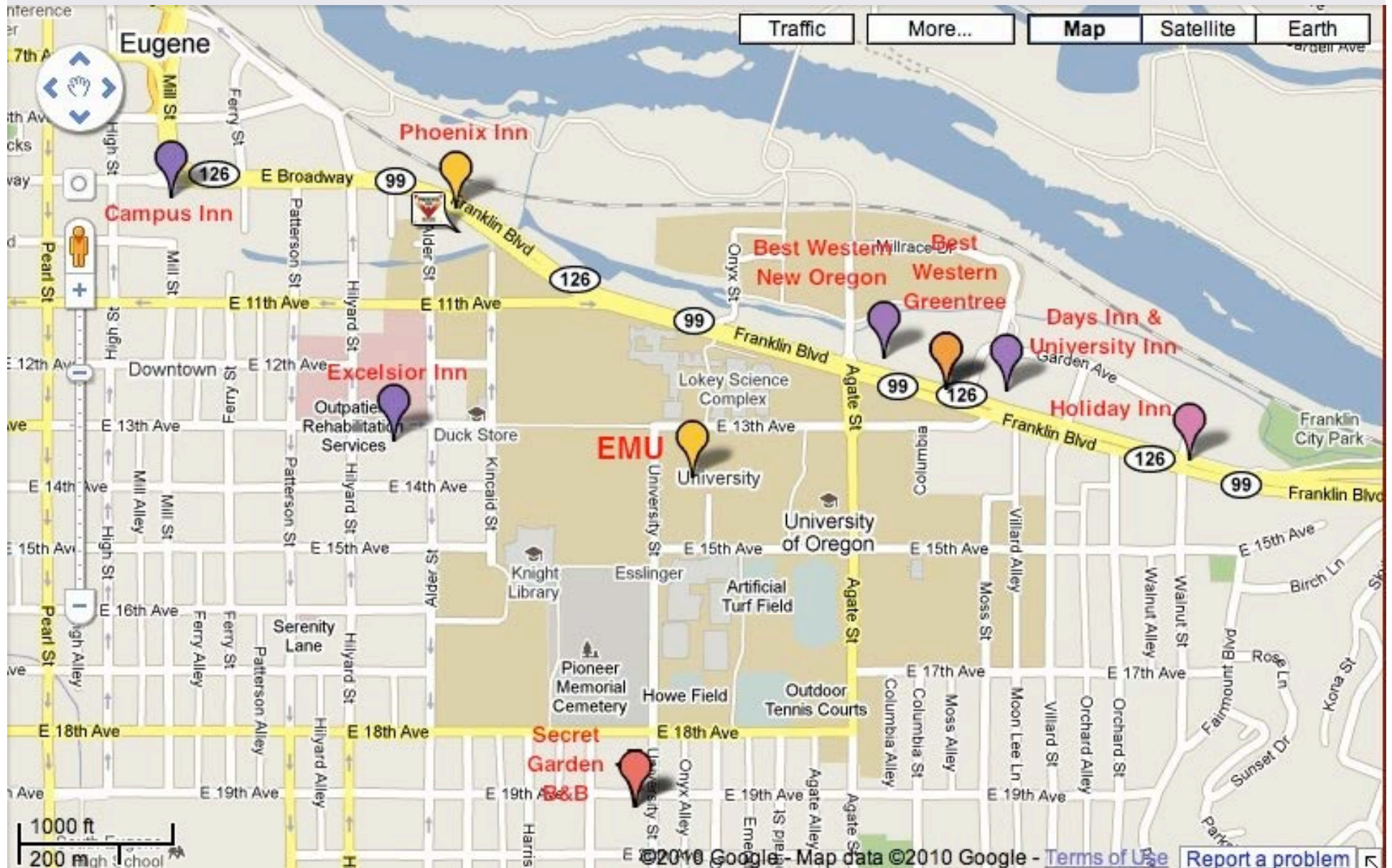
The Eugene Airport (EUG) is the second busiest airport in the state of Oregon and the fifth-largest airport in the Pacific Northwest. Owned and operated by the City of Eugene, it is classified by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as a small-hub airport in the national airport system. The airfield at EUG is known as Mahlon Sweet Field.

Airlines Serving EUG

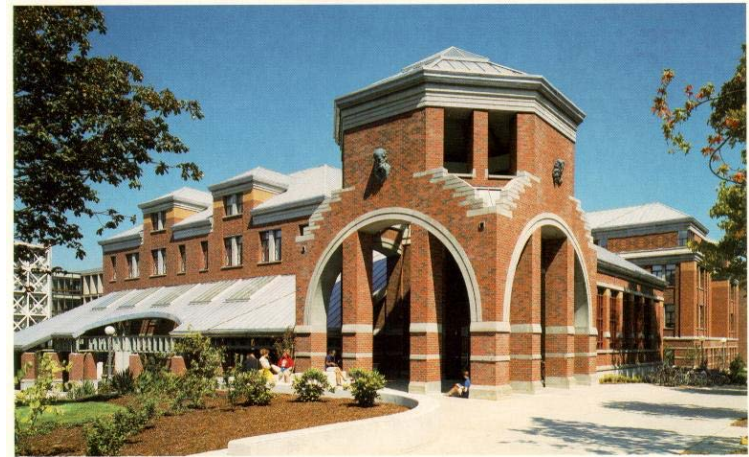
