  - Mailing lists, CVS repository, Savannah bug-tracker
- Main source repository now on SourceForge
  - Migrated as snapshot (without history)
  - See <a href="http://quattor.svn.sourceforge.net/viewvc/quattor/">http://quattor.svn.sourceforge.net/viewvc/quattor/</a>
  - 22 developers registered so far
  - Build tools basically work
