- CE's are difficult to install & Configure
 - Authentication & Authorization schemes (host certs!)
 - Batch system configuration
- For small opportunistic sites, difficult on-ramp.

Difficulties in current solution

Advantages of CE-Bosco

- Built upon previous work on Bosco, designed to access opportunistic computing.
 - Flexible HTCondor-CE is specially configured to send jobs to a remote bosco enabled endpoint.
- Can centrally add clusters with only a user account on the remote cluster.
- Centrally managed authentication & authorization
- Easy on-ramp for opportunistic resoruces
