Accounting Portal

 ALICE does not depend on the accounting portal view



Accounting Reports

- The T0/T1 report is very useful and the format is clear
- •Efficiencies are still >100% for some of the VOs, masking the VOs with 'correct' efficiencies
- The T2 reports are in CPU time, should be Wall time
- The T2 federation view does not give sufficient information on the individual sites delivery



Multicore accounting

 ALICE does not depend on multicore accounting



Opportunistic resources

 ALICE does not depend on centralized accounting tools for opportunistic (non-WLCG sites) resources



Space accounting

- ALICE does its own space accounting for all SE types
- •Xrootd/EOS dual accounting through the AliEn catalogue (indirect) and xrootd information from servers (direct)
- DPM and dCache have only indirect accounting



REBUS

- •REBUS is used for pledged and required resources accounting
- A historical view within one year would be very useful for accounting purposes
- •A view of non-WLCG resources should be possible (opportunistic or sites without WLCG affiliation)
- Currently installed capacity needs to be recorded and can go in the historical view within one year
- T2s should be entered in REBUS per site, not as a federation
