DPM current status



- 1 FTE working on LFC & DPM in the group: Unlikely to increase
 - Contributions most welcome
- DPM 1.7.0-6 is the last stable release on SLC4 (since 12 May)
- DPM 1.7.2-4 is being certified
 - SLC4 was certified last week
 - SLC5 still being processed
- 1.7.2-4 changes:
 - Fix problem in rfio with Iseek (bug #43382)
 - New python interface 'dpm2'
 - Preserve the result of gridftp checksum requests in the DPNS
 - Some changes needed for SLC5
 - Few other minor bug fixes





Roadmap



- Priorities
 - Stability, Reliability, Maintainability
 - Given limited manpower and stability requirement because of LHC startup
- Upgrade of xrootd base
 - Intend that the patch is not specific to DPM version
- Next DPM release to certification at the end of June
 - Multi VO support for xrootd
 - (Foreseen for analysis use, as is also the case for CASTOR)
- Then consolidate
 - Utility to remove historical data from database
 - Address open (minor) bugs

Features

- Gateway function for disk servers (allow some disk servers to have private IP address)
- Automatic calculation of checksums in rfio
- User/VO banning
- Admin role
- Other FS selection methods
- Quotas
