Do I need my own funds? (scholarship)

NO!

Nearly all European and North American
PhD's program come with funding.



Often **Teaching** is the way you will fund your PhD!

How to apply?

To start a PhD program, you have to **APPLY**.

It is a **LONG** process and you have to **START** it at least **1 YEAR** before you finish your master.

PhD in the heart of the empire (U.S.A.)

- It is fine to send an email to professors and ask questions (*Nabil*)
- CV (*David*), motivation letter, 3 recommendation letters.
- English proficiency test: **TOEFL**.
- **GRE** (*Graduate Record Examination*)

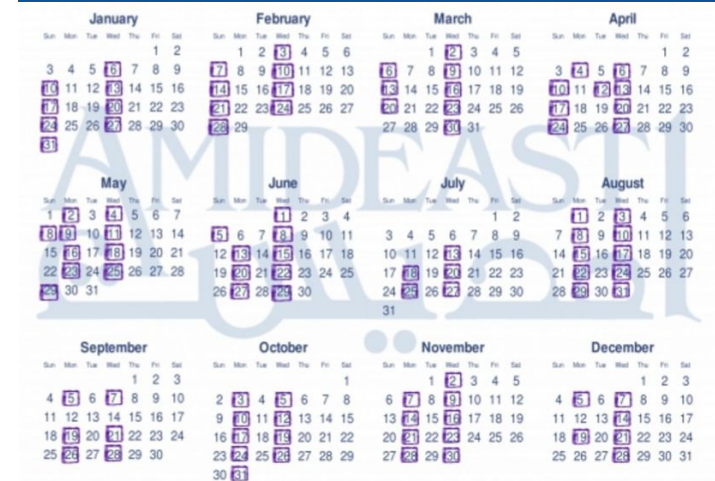

Application Process

All application materials must be received by Cornell no later than December 15. All supporting documents, including academic transcripts, test scores, and

PhD in the periphery of the empire (U.K.)

- It is fine to send an email to professors and ask questions (*Nabil*)

- English *proficiency* test: **TOEFL** or **IELTS**.
- Deadlines may vary, but the earlier the better.

PhD in the empire wannabe (France, Germany, Italy, ...)

There are PhD with scholarships offered in many EU countries. Process may vary:

- Check on the website the procedure for application [google: *University physics graduate program apply*]
- It is fine to send an email to professors and ask questions about the process and research (*Nabil*).
- Start the process in advance. At least **1 YEAR** before you finish your master!
