
1st line support and R-COD organization in SEE ROC

- The SEE ROC comprises of 7 countries
- Each country has a "country representative" person in SEE ROC
- The country representative oversees the 1st line support in the country
- Each country may have also other persons performing 1st line support
- The "country representative" will be initially R-COD member (or can designate a deputy for this work)
- The BG team will ensure the smooth transition to a fully national model with a backup R-COD for alarms and tickets that are not taken care of within 48 hours
- Initial training of country representatives has been performed.



1st line support and R-COD organization in SEE ROC


- 1st line supporters:
 - Analyse new SAM alarms in regional dashboard at CIC portal
 - Also watch other monitoring tools (Nagios, Gstat)
 - 1st line supporters can open tickets in regional helpdesk when they believe an alarm requires such ticket.
- If no resolution within 24 hours country R-COD member reacts.
- If no action from country representative within 48 hours BG team opens ticket.
- Communication within a country depends on the situation within the country in some cases small number of sites and direct contact between 1st line support and site administrators.
- Greece has registered many R-CODs because they are going to implement periodic shifts of R-COD. At least for the beginning (every 2 weeks we will have a team).





Regional helpdesk

- The regional helpdesk integrates tickets related to all countries in the region EGEE or outside EGEE and maintains interoperability with GGUS.
- National helpdesks are not currently available in most countries, except perhaps GR.
- The helpdesk has a knowledgebase.
- A nagios portal at IPP allows (semi-)automatic ticket opening related to test failures.
- It is expected that 1st line support will open such tickets when they consider an alarm to require such a ticket.






Other regional tools

- Other countries in the region, that are not part of EGEE, are also tested from B&H and results are published in the BBMSAM portal, which may incorporate many kinds of tests and can monitor SLA directly.
