Total procurement budget >5M€

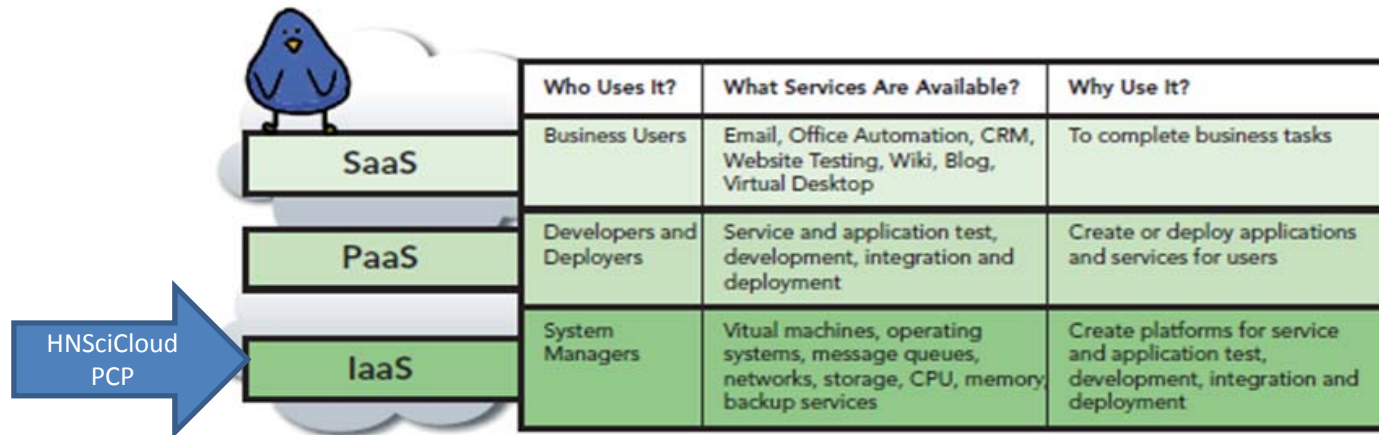


What will be procured

A hybrid cloud platform for the European research community



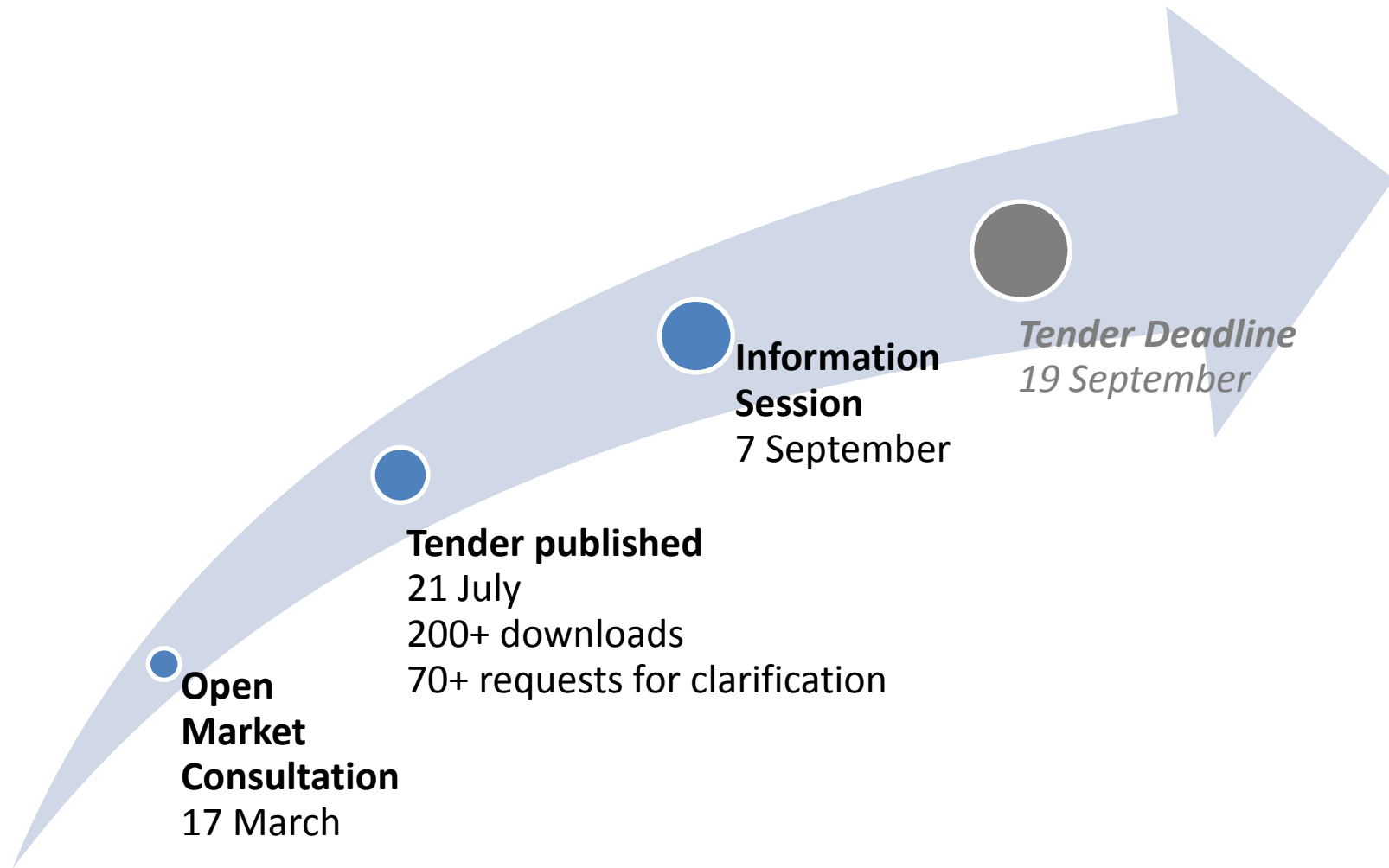
Combining services at the IaaS level to support science workflows

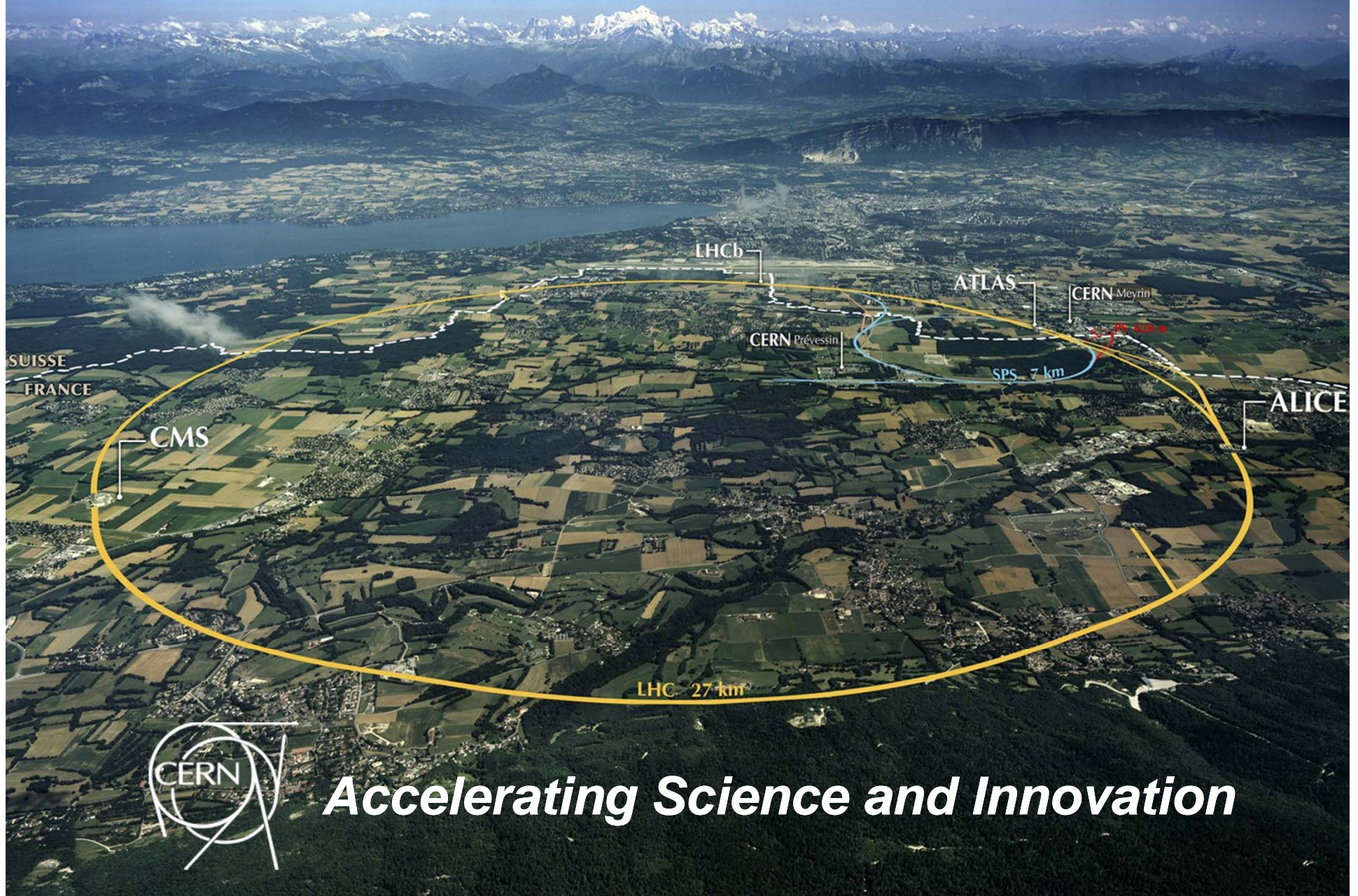
