





EB Report – Ken Long Highlights



- Revision of collaboration list, author list

 - Staffing issues (US, DL, PH/controls)

EB/Spokesperson's Report continued


- Response to STFC decision (extended step IV only)
 - Reply from KL + PS welcoming support for Step IV, acknowledging Cooling Demo not approved on grounds of cost, promising revised Cooling Demo proposal when Step IV established.

 - EB to follow up & seek funding


Shift Report – Steve Boyd

Common Fund – Paul Soler

- 66 (PhD equivalent) contributors
- £198K income expected (£168K cash, £30K in kind)
- Must finalise now invoices about to be sent out
- '15-16 expenditure (inc. cryogens) £272K
 - Balance further in the red
 - Hope to recover over coming years



Funding Updates

- UK: C2C review only supported extended Step IV. Run to end 2017; funding to June 2018, then no support for PostDocs.
- US: No change. No point in NSF bid.
- INFN: Current funding to continue for next year.
- Gva: Result of request for 2 years funding in August.
- Bulgaria: Requesting €50K inc. CF. Rely on TNA.
