- With reduced manpower (e.g. due to EGEE → EGI), the WLCG collaboration needs to become more pro-active. We saw an example of this with dCache during the workshop.
 - → the dCache workshop was user-driven and was an excellent idea. We need to follow up and form a working group
- We should do the same for DPM, StoRM, and BeStMan. We will have a pre-GDB meeting on storage to get this started.
- Other topics?
- We need to move towards a system of "users supporting users"





Service Credit for Common Computing

- Some experiments give service credit for distributed computing, while some do not, or only do so for limited tasks
- This should be treated in a consistent manner and there is general agreement on this point
- However, there is concern about double counting of people in Tier centres that support more than one activity
- WLCG seems like an appropriate body to verify claims
- I will continue to negotiate this with the experiments.
