CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE CZECH REPUBLIC, HUNGARY, POLAND AND THE SLOVAK REPUBLIC

On 29 September 1994, Committee of Council, when discussing the question of the contributions of the Czech Republic, Hungary, Poland and the Slovak Republic (CERN/CC/2061), also examined the proposal that until the Net National Incomes of these countries are available, it should be assumed that in each case the NNI is equal to 76.6% of the Gross Domestic Product, which is the simple average for all the other Member States.

At its 16 December 1994 Session (CERN/2079), Council approved the transition contributions arrangement for these four countries (CERN/2069).

To allow the calculation of the contributions of these countries, Council is now invited to approve the above-mentioned proposal.
