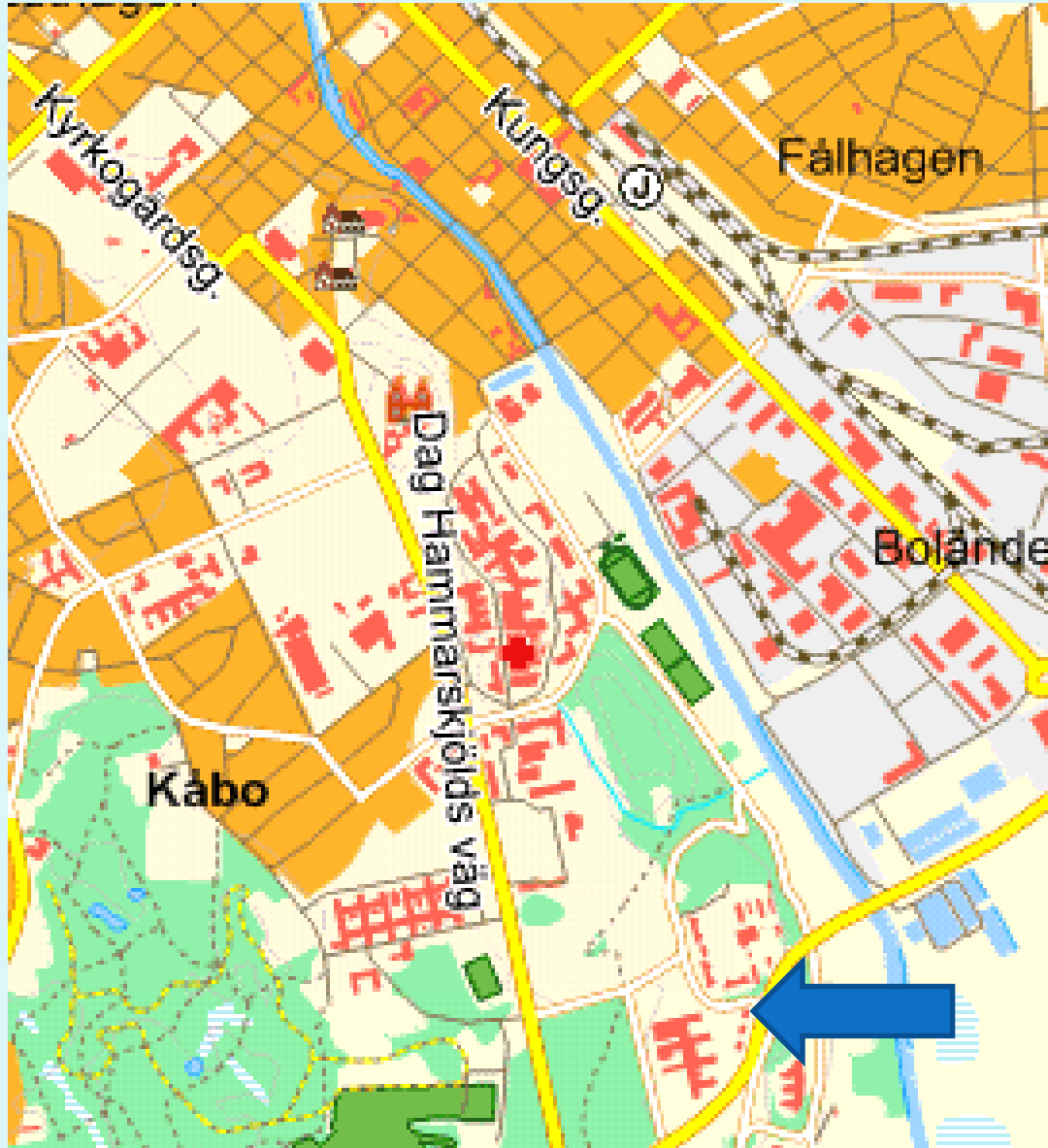

Uppsala University was founded in 1477 and is the oldest university in Scandinavia. It has 40 000 students and 5000 employees of which the Department of Physics and Astronomy has 300 employees.

The Department has a High Energy Physics Division active in ATLAS and IceCube and an Accelerator Division (FREIA Laboratory) currently testing and developing superconducting RF cavities, including high power RF generators, and magnets for ESS and LHC upgrade.
