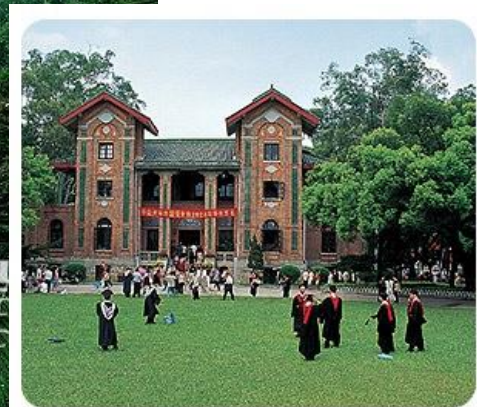
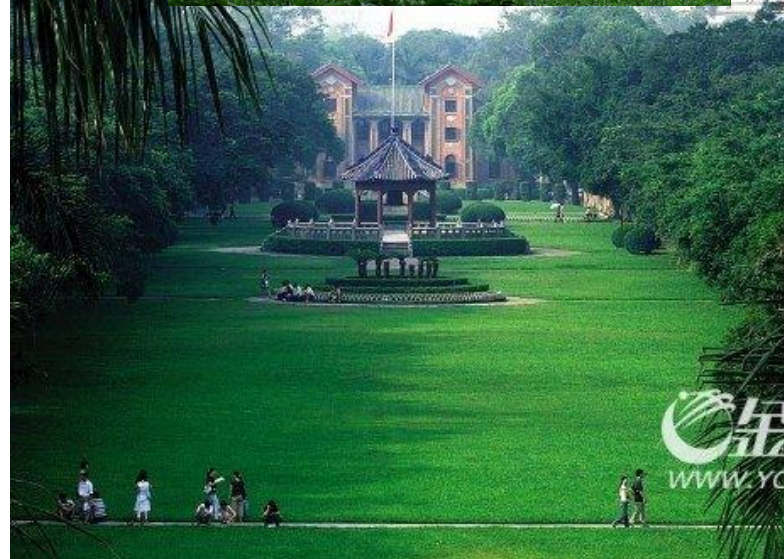
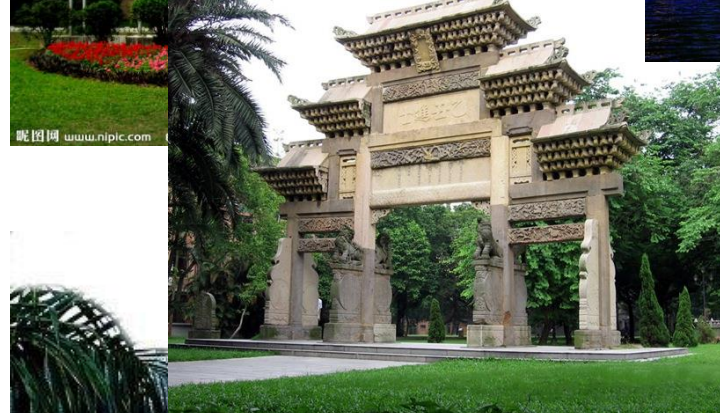
A Few Words about Guangzhou and Zhujiang Delta



- **The capital city of Guangdong Province (Canton), one of the so-called 4 Tier 1 cities.**
- **The oldest open port in South China. Has rich history and is also highly international.**
- **Famous for Chinese and fusion food, where dim-sum was invented. :)**
- **One of the most popular tourist destinations; Fantastic for biking and walking.**

A Brief List of (Important) Facts of SYSU

- **SYSU: Sun Yat-Sen University, Guangzhou, China**
 - Funded by Dr. Sun Yat-Sen, the founder of the Republic of China in 1924
 - Undergraduate students ~32,000; graduate students ~20,000
 - Faculty members (associate professors and up) ~4,000
 - The best university in South China; One of the top 10 physics programs in China;
 - One of the most beautiful campuses in China

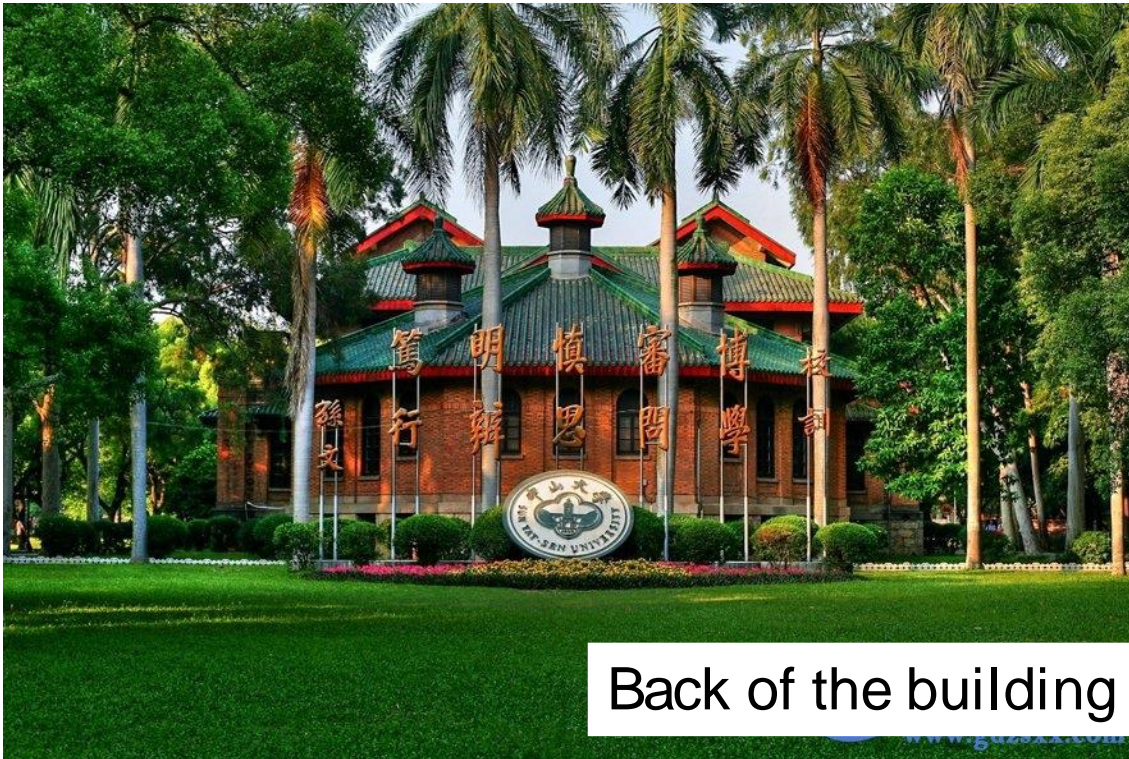


Main Venue

- **Leung Kau Kui Tong** (Liangqiuju Hall, on campus)
 - Main hall can host ~1,400 people; A few smaller rooms which can host ~40-50 people for registration, business center, IT supports and committee meetings etc

Back of the building

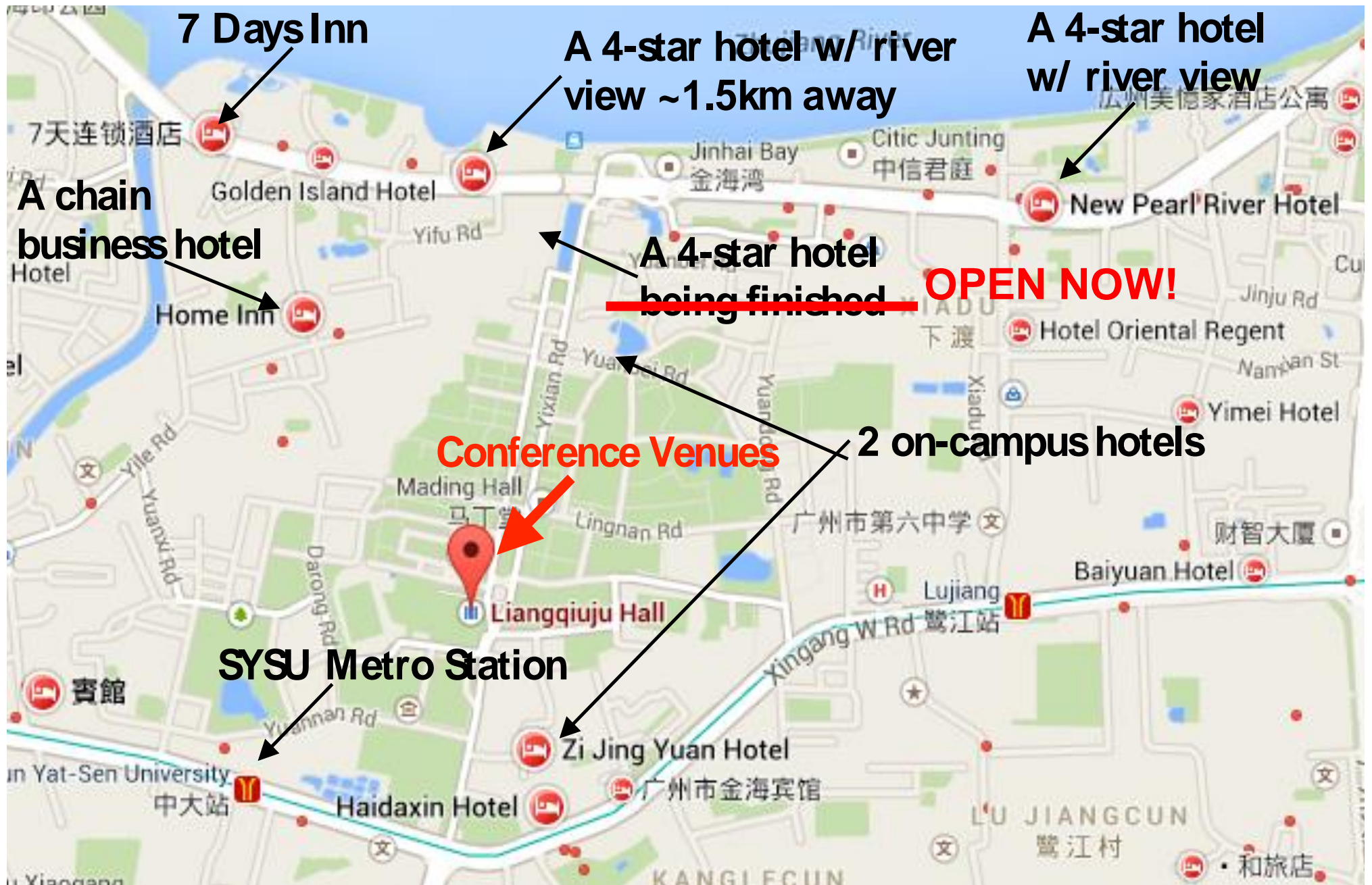


Front of the building

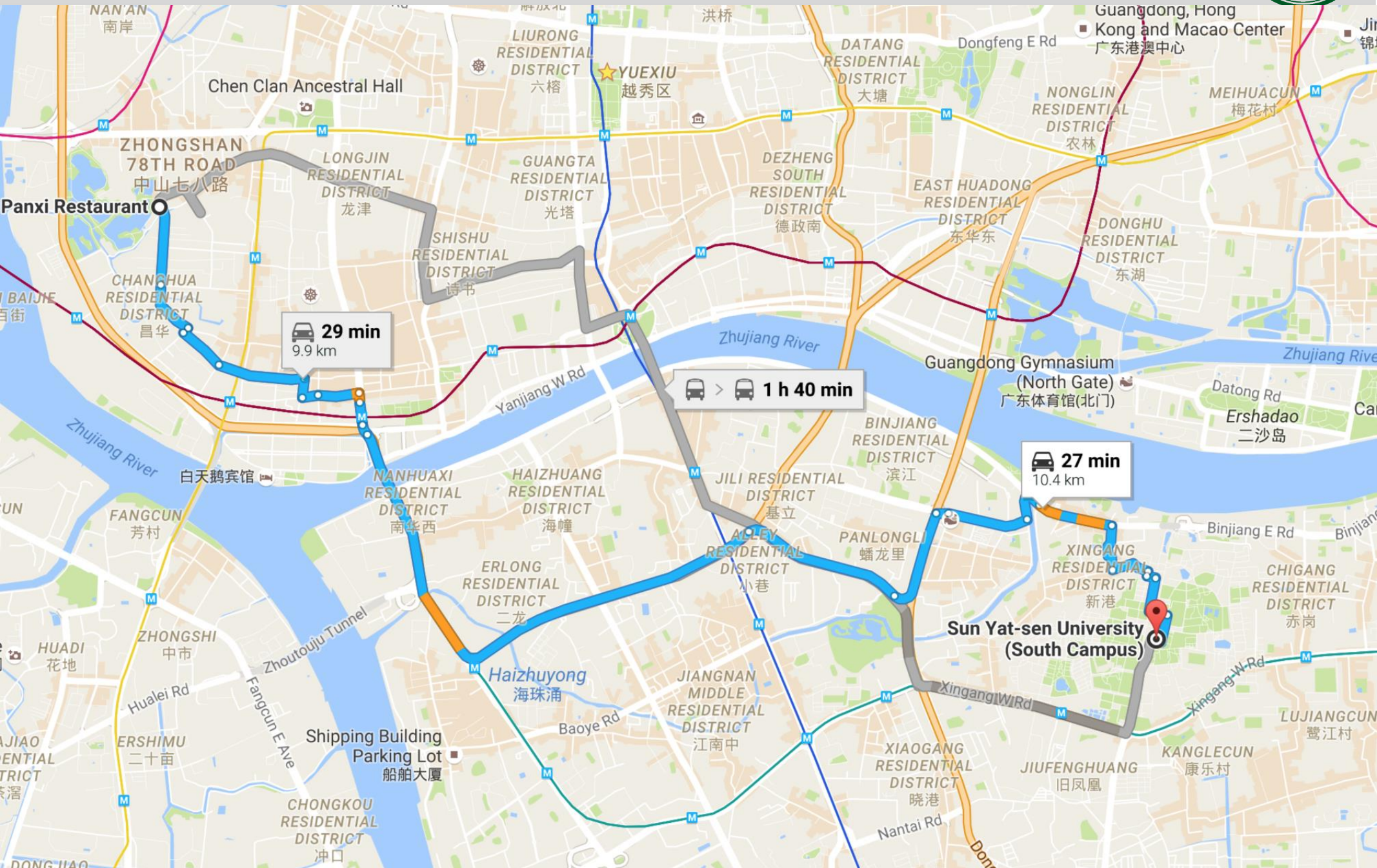
- The historical Huaishi Hall can host ~250 participants comfortably
