IPAC17 is part of JACoW and therefore has agreed to their policies and requirements for publication. Originally created for the publication of the proceedings of the Asian, European and North American particle accelerator conferences (which in 2010 became the IPAC series), today the site www.jacow.org hosts the proceedings of several dozens of collaboration conferences. The JACoW collaboration has established several policies and technical requirements for publishing on JACoW. The policies are reviewed at the annual team meetings. The technical requirements are reviewed as the need arises. JACoW publishes all conference proceedings under the Creative Commons Attribution 3.0 license in order to permit its wide dissemination and use.

Applied aspects



- Public lecture on the first day of the conference
- Industry Exhibition with over 100 exhibitors is planned, naturally from industries that have a connection with the conference subject. The Industry Session on the Tuesday afternoon aims at further strengthening the bond between science and industry.
- The publication of a new & updated edition of a “Booklet of Future Accelerator Projects” should provide additional insight into application of science.
- Traditionally the conference has a good session balance of theory and design-construction and operation of accelerators.

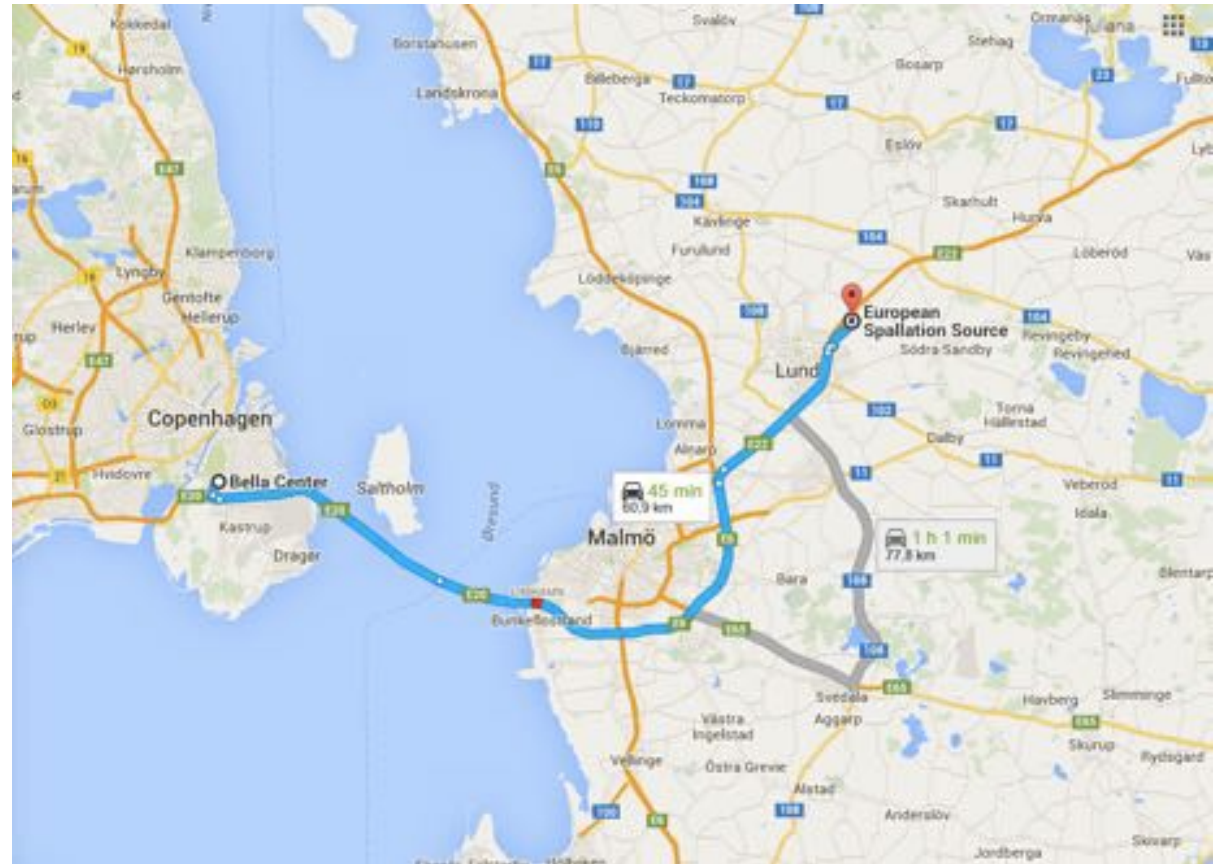


Field Trip (FRI)
