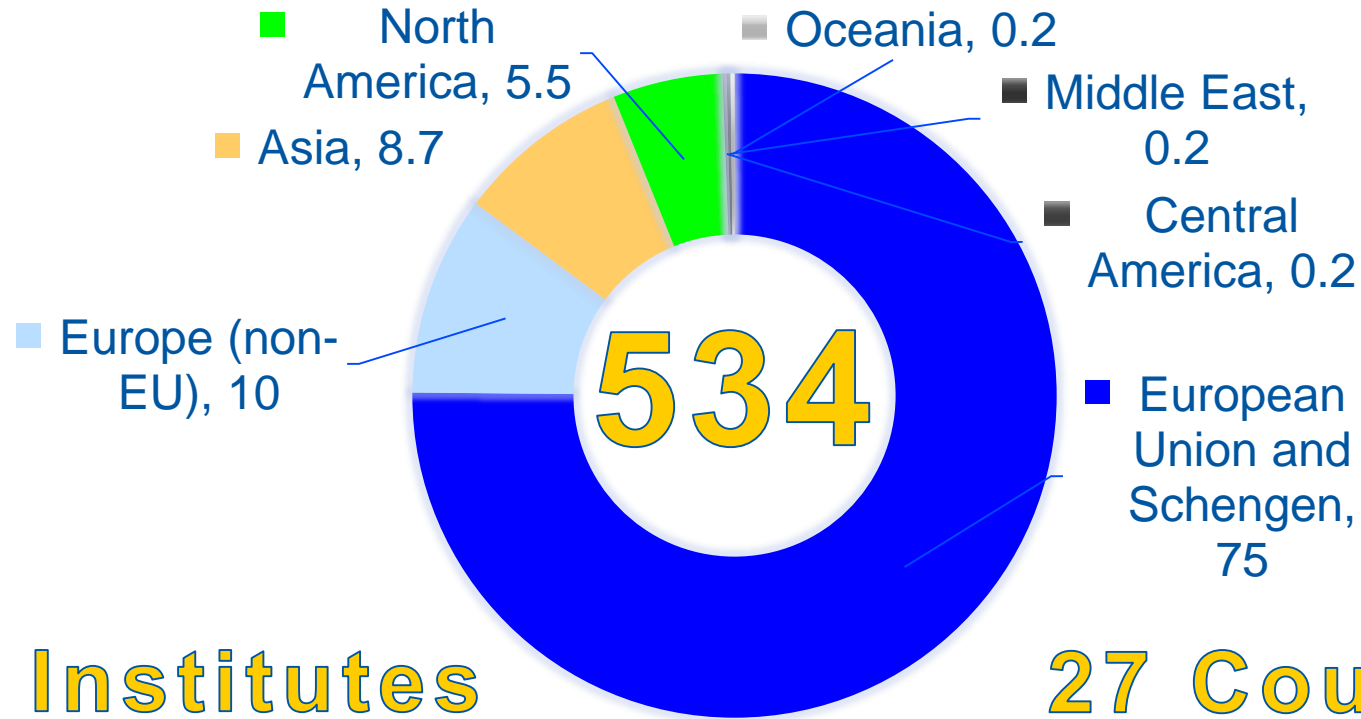

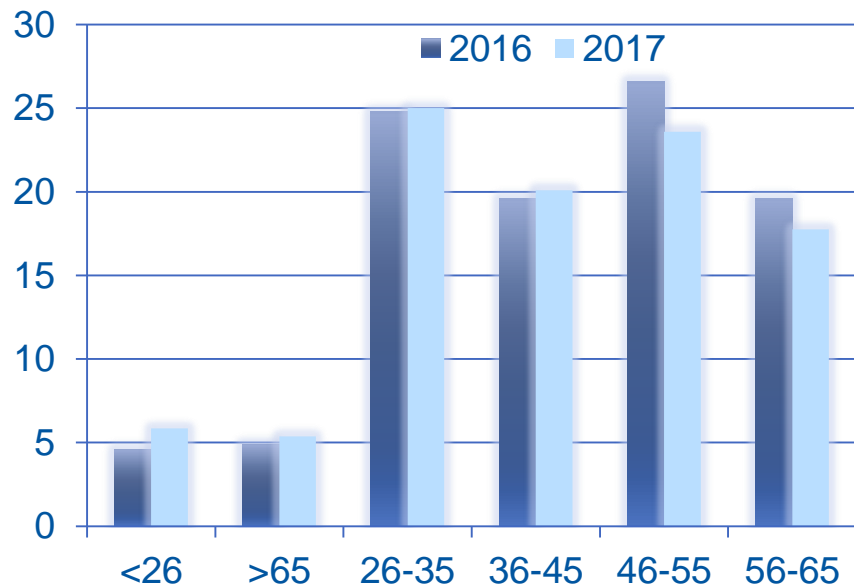
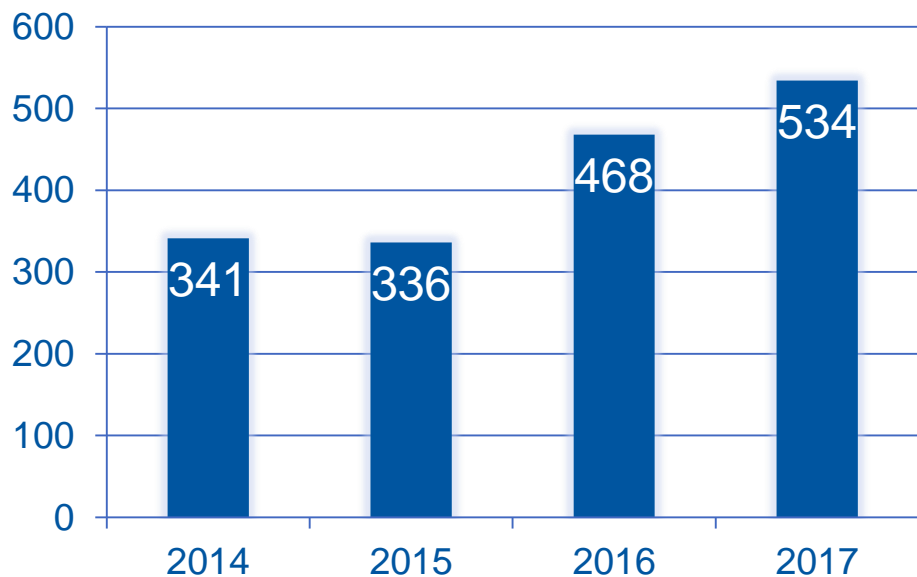
Participants - Area Distribution



147 Institutes

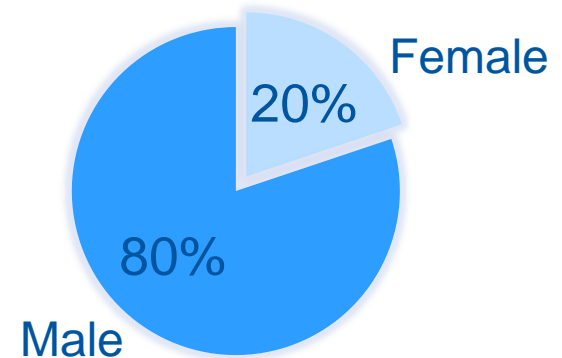
27 Countries
