Maintainers (WIP)

- Leaders of the project
- Service people: Help you contribute to Invenio.
- Types:
 - Core maintainers (determines overall architecture)
 - Module maintainers (domain experts)

Project

- **Break the learning curve:**
 - Tutorials, demo site, training, cookbooks, thorough documentation, boot up time
- **Empower the collaboration:**
 - Contribution simplification, transparency, communication facilitators, Invenio-wide emergency response, architecture.
- **Focus the discussion:**
 - Style automation, nightly builds, bots, automatic rules enforcement, ...
