



STRUCTURE OF ORGANIZATION

In CERN/65, circulated at the Seventh Session of the Council, the top-level organization was determined as follows:-



In the light of subsequent comments, notably by the British Delegation (CERN/69 Rev.- dated 30 - 3 - 54), and of examination by the Executive Group, Council now intends that the structure of the Organization should be shown as follows:-



- 1) PS = Proton-Synchrotron Division
- 2) SC = Synchro-cyclotron Division
- 3) ST = Scientific and Technical Services Division
- 4) B = Site and Building Division
- 5) T = Theoretical Studies Division
- 6) A = Administration Division

Note : The Director-General will appoint an Executive Group to consist of members of the Directorate and of Directors of Divisions.

Scientific co-operation will be a function of the Directorate.

EUROPEAN COUNCIL FOR NUCLEAR RESEARCH

NOTE ON THE APPOINTMENT OF A DIRECTOR

1. Council has in mind that the top level Organization should be as shown in the attached chart.
2. Provision is made for two committees of the Council :
 - a) Finance Committee;
 - b) Scientific Policy Committee.
3. The Terms of Reference of the Finance Committee are already defined in broad terms in the Financial Protocol and in detail in the Financial Rules.
4. Council intends that the main Terms of Reference of the Scientific Policy Committee shall be as follows:

"To review, consider and make recommendation to the Council on:
 - a) the scientific policy of the Organization;
 - b) the allocation of financial resources between the various activities of the Organization."
5. Council reaffirms its view that the Director will exercise undivided administrative control of the whole Organization.

Note: Item 5 of this document should be amended according to the remarks made by the Executive Group in para.3 of CERN/87.
