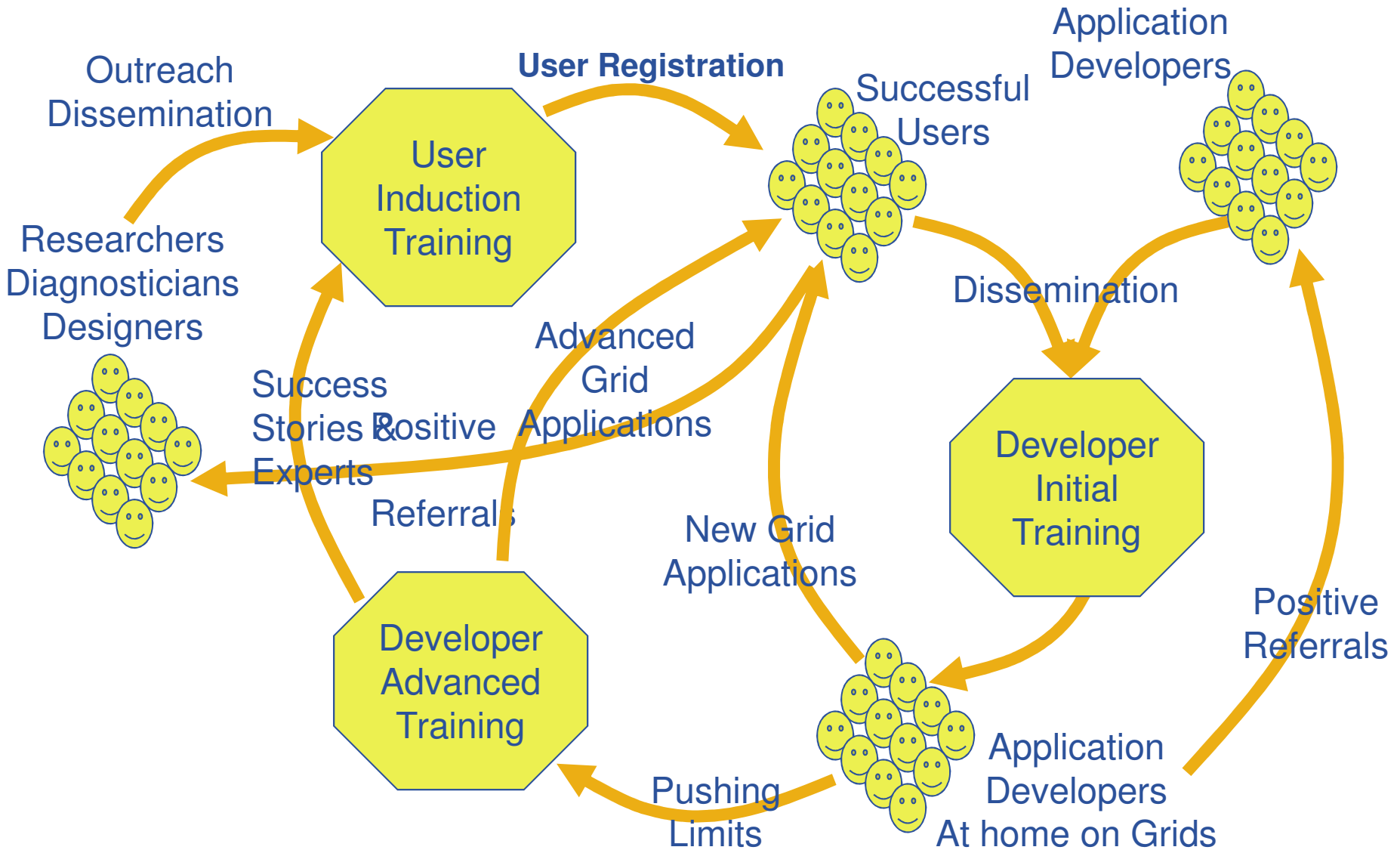

Trainers power Virtuous Cycles



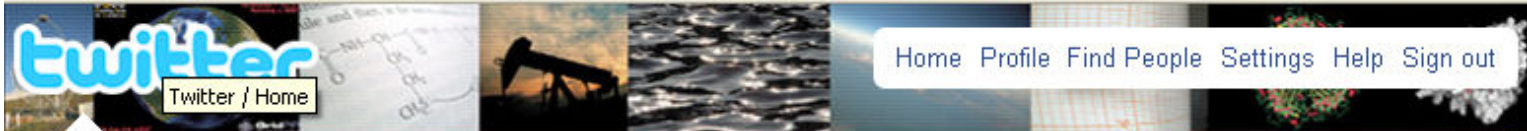
- **Training will not be structured like EGEE**
 - Federated Infrastructure
- **Training will still be required:**
 - System operators (Operation centres)
 - Application developers (developing programs using infrastructure)
 - Users (accessing services)

- **Trainers will continue to need:**
 - Training (particularly new trainers)
 - Dissemination support
 - Shared experience of system changes
 - Passing info onto communities
 - Local
 - Across VOs
 - Support services
 - Infrastructure for Training
 - *Students need “easy access”*
 - Training Material

- **1FTE**
- **Coordination of NGI efforts**
- **Training Material**
 - Gathering technical information
 - Create content
- **Support central services**
 - Material repository
 - Online resources
- **No Support for t-Infrastructure**

- **Material Creation, live or broadcast events, provision of web based materials**
- **Maintain local repositories, e-Learning**
- **Support regional t-Infrastructure**
 - Coordination & interoperation
 - Operations at site level

- **Sustainability**
 - NGIs self-sufficient
 - Increase number of Trainers
- **Scalability**
 - Large increase users -> Strain on resources
