## The Role of the COLLIDE Scientific Partner

- ⤴ **Friendly Contact and Guide.** To be one of the artist in residence's main point of contact and guide, together with Mónica Bello (Head of Arts@CERN), and Julian Calo (Coordinator of Arts@CERN), to CERN science, people and CERN environment.
- ⤴ **Active Discussant.** To engage into discussions and ideas with the artist in a two way exchange of knowledge between arts and science to create meaningful interaction between both parties.
- ⤴ **Introducer and Facilitator.** To enable introductions for the artist to relevant people, places and ideas about particle physics following weekly meetings.

## The Commitments of the COLLIDE Scientific Partner

- ⤴ To meet with the artists in residence once a week, either virtually (if travelling) or in person - exact times to be fixed by you both.
- ⤴ To give a public lecture with the artist in residence at CERN during the period of the residency (date to be defined), or other format of public event defined by the curator. The objective of this is to express and show the motivations of working together and to showcase the research and ideas of each.
- ⤴ To be available as required for selected press and media interviews about the residency and process.

\*Please note, in addition, opportunities to appear at international conferences with the artist as part of the COLLIDE programme will occur, and are subject to your availability.
