


CHIPP EB activities since Sept. 2008

The EB meets about 9 times a year. Activities were:

- finalisation and publication of the fact sheets on Swiss contribution to LHC in d, f, i, e (see www.chipp.ch);
- preparation of R-ECFA visit to CH (March 2009, EPFL);
- ProDoc: new request prepared and submitted;
- PostDocs: all 9 positions now filled, last three (with a specific IT component) for ATLAS, CMS and LHCb (common selection by the institutes working on the same detector). Excellent reponse to the advertisement (54 good quality candidates; 14 shortlisted for interviews);
- Workshops: on neutrino physics (ETHZ, November 2008), Higgs Boson Phenomenology (U.ZH, Jan 2009), Astroparticle Physics (EPFL, June 2009)
- Attribution of CHIPP Prize in 2009


future meetings supported by CHIPP
