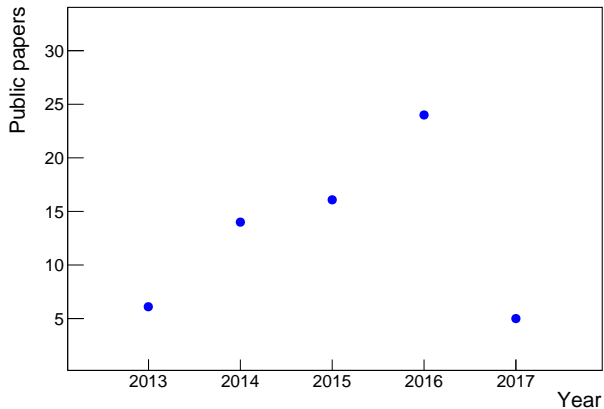

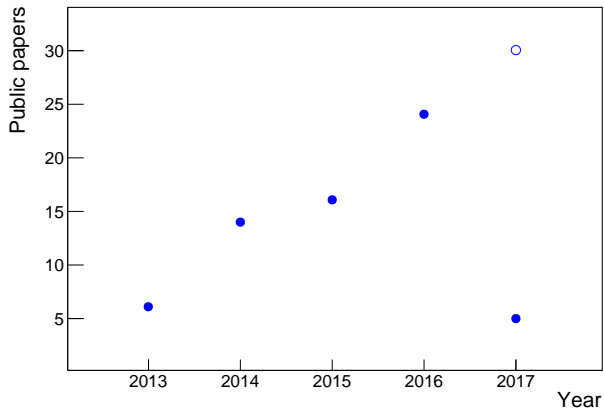

Collaboration review time is (Annex 4 of MoC):

- 2 weeks for journal paper
- 2 weeks for public notes
- 1 week for conference proceedings

Drafts under review are listed on twiki:

Please note that additional time (can sum up to one additional week) is needed for initial review, implementation of changes and final checks...

Submitting the paper
