- ✓ Yesterday an International Cooperation Agreement with the Government of Sri Lanka.



Funding for the LIU and HL-LHC projects

✓ In September, a credit facility agreement with the European Investment Bank in order to meet the Organization's cash-flow needs during the peak construction period of the LIU and HL-LHC projects



Pension Fund matters

- ✓ establishment of a working group on the governance of the Pension Fund, which started its work in November,
- ✓ technical amendments to the Rules of the Pension Fund, required for the implementation of CERN's new career structure,
- ✓ technical amendments to the Agreement between CERN and ESO concerning the admission of ESO staff to the CERN Pension Fund



Other decisions

- ✓ technical amendments to certain benefits, contributions and affiliation conditions under the CERN Health Insurance Scheme,
- ✓ an overall cost-variation index of -2.39% and 0% indexation of Member States' contributions for 2017,
- ✓ the addition of the CERN Entrepreneurship Student Programme to the list of projects funded by the CERN & Society Foundation.
