

Timeline of project in UK

- Started in 2012 at the Universities of Bristol and Bath
- Established in 2013 at the University of Birmingham
- Currently spreading to Wales and South England at the Universities of Cardiff and Sussex
- Schools range from private to comprehensive a total of 50 schools
- Three schools received grants from the Royal Society in purchasing their detectors


Map of UK HiSPARC detectors

Examples of student research

- Day-night variation of cosmic rays
- Investigating link between certain weather factors (e.g. pressure, temperature) and cosmic rays
- Investigating link between solar cycle and cosmic rays
- Locating sources of cosmic rays
- Calculating primary particle angle
