Dear Marek,

thank you for your e-mail on 20th of November and the good news about the possibility to organize CPO2018 in Corfu. Concerning the dates and duration of the meeting we definitely prefer the second half of September 2018. In particular the dates 24-28 of September are fine with us. In that case the reception would be on Sunday the 23rd (including offering of drinks) while the departure on Saturday the 29th of September 2018. Thus, the workshop will close on Friday the 28th having a duration of 5 days.

As exposed also in the brochure, for a single person in a single room the cost is 102 € per night including breakfast and dinner plus 15 € per lunch plus 150 € conference fee which includes reception, banquet, excursion, etc. This amount for the fee assumes that the workshop takes place in Mon Repos (less than 150 participants). In the case we have more than 150 participants the meetings would take place in a different hotel and consequently the fee will increase to 200 €.

Concerning the international visibility of the Workshop there would be information with posters in all highly ranked Universities and related Research Institutes worldwide. Furthermore there would be announcements in all relevant electronic sides. Additionally there would also be an extensive local outreach program containing a series of activities including seminars for the public as well as the teachers in high schools, presentations in radio and TV (undertaken mainly by Greek people participating in the workshop).
