- 1 Agenda was approved unanimously.
- 2 Report from the CPOD 2018 LOC:

Nikos Antoniou and Fotis Diakonos presented a brief summary from the organization of CPOD 2018. 80 physicists attended the workshop. 57 plenary talks were presented. They included invited talks (45 min), regular contributed talks (30 min) and flash talks (15 min). The workshop received an unexpectedly low financial support from external sources. Therefore, the conference fee was set to be 250 EUR instead of the originally planned 150 EUR. 18 students were supported using conference fee funds. The proceedings will be published in PoS without page restrictions for invited and regular contributed talks.

The IAC congratulates the LOC for the workshop organization. In particular, the workshop format with only plenary talks and ample time for discussion was praised. It was the general opinion that the scientific program and the presented new results were of high importance and well-focused on the CPOD physics priorities. The IAC would wish closer interactions of the LOC with IAC shortly before the workshop to ensure inclusion of the latest results. The increased conference fee of 250 EUR was still in the lower range of CPOD conference fees.

3 Discussion on subjects and format of future CPOD workshops

It was stressed to keep the focus on the priorities of CPOD. In 2020 new experimental results from NA61, STAR and HADES are expected. Moreover, experimental results from astrophysics are of growing importance for the CPOD workshops.

It was concluded to preserve the workshop format of CPOD, similar to the Corfu meeting. The LOC should work closely with the IAC in formulation of the workshop programme.

4 Changes of the IAC membership

Nikos Antoniou (TH(CP)) the co-chair of CPOD 2018, was invited to join the IAC. The invitation was accepted.

Our tradition is to replace members of the IAC that are not active any more in the field and/or cannot participate in the CPOD workshops. At the same time, we ensure that representatives of all major experimental and theoretical activities participate in the IAC.

At this meeting it has been stressed that we should make an effort to enhance the number of female members on the board. In view of the above it has been suggested to replace Francesco Becattini, Krishna Rajagopal and Peter Senger by

- Hannah Elfner/Petersen (Frankfurt) TH(HYDRO),
- Marlene Nahrgang (Nantes) TH(CP),
- Tetyana Galatyuk (Darmstadt) CBM,

- Vladimir Kekelidze (Dubna) NICA.

Marek will contact all of them on this subject (updated status of this process is given at the end of this document).
