

Traveling from the Airport to the University of Oslo

After leaving the baggage claiming area, the trains are down the hall to the right almost at the end. There you will see some NSB ticket machines and a person standing in NSB uniform that is available to help if needed. You will need to buy a ticket to Oslo Central Station (Oslo S). This ticket will last you for one hour and is valid for all public transport within Oslo city, enough time to get you all the way to the institute. When arriving at Oslo Central Station you should find the T-bane (metro). The sign is a T within a circle.

You will have to go to the Westbound platform and take one of the following T-bane

5 Sognsvann

5 Ringen via Majorstuen

4 Vestli via Majorstuen

to the stop "Blindern".

When walking from the Blindern stop you should walk up the hill and cross the road, going towards the large, black building straight ahead. When coming to the front door of that building (the university library), you turn to the right and walk straight down. The building you see at the end is the institute of physics.
