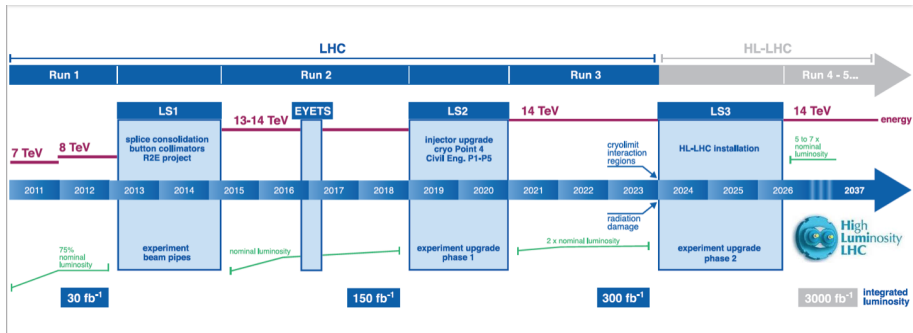
- Catalyze new common projects
