Google Summer of Code (GSoC)

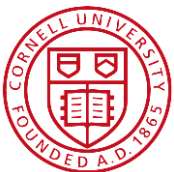
- Created in 2005 to:
 - Expose students to real Open Source projects
 - Bring new talent and ideas into Open Source
- This year, bigger than ever
 - 201 organisations
 - 1318 students
- SFT participating since 2011
 - Started with 4 students working on CernVM
- 2017: evolution into an umbrella organisation:
CERN-HEP Software Foundation
 - **26 students** accepted (12 last year)

52 Mentors



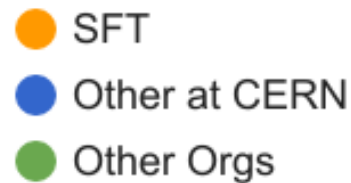
SFT and CERN Participation

- SFT participation remains stable
