

Automatic building of pull-requests (ghprb)

- @phsft-bot
- Initiate build on PR by commenting: "@phsft-bot build"
- IMPORTANT:
 Skim through changes before building
- PRs by whitelisted members are automatically built
- Organization members whitelisted
- GitHub hook for initiating root-incremental-master (Push)



Motivation for GitHub rename (root-mirror)

- Current organization name: root-mirror
- GitHub becomes more central in development
- Repos will soon no longer serve as mirror
- More appropriate name would lead to better communication and stronger profile on GitHub

Side-effects of renaming

- Organization name becomes available for registration https://github.com/root-mirror/
 -> HTTP 404
- Repo links are automatically redirected:
 https://github.com/root-mirror/root -> https://github.com/root-cern/root
 https://github.com/root-mirror/root.git -> https://github.com/root-cern/root.git
- Pull requests, contributors, forks, stars, metadata preserved
- Mentions @root-mirror are NOT automatically redirected
- Recommended to update old external links (Twitter, LinkedIn, etc.)
- Re-register the old organization after rename to avoid "repo hijacking"
- Service integrations may break (Jenkins, Travis CI, ...)

Example: opscode -> chef

- >240 repositories
- Announcement to the community when it would perform the rename http://lists.opscode.com/sympa/arc/chef/2015-01/msg00166.html
- Registered new organization (chef)
- Moved over repositories one-by-one (Part of QA approach)
- https://github.com/opscode/chef -> https://github.com/chef/chef
- Old organization page (opscode) contains information of the rename

Summary

- GitHub pull request builder working
- Web-hook for commits initiates job in Jenkins (Push)
- Proposed rename of root-mirror as it no longer is a mirror
- Links to repos will redirect after rename
- Old organization page will not redirect
- Re-register the old organization name with info on new name
 Alternatively: Register new name and move over repos (Safer, permissions lost)
