



The main media area will be in the reception tent, equipped with live video streaming of the ceremony, Internet connectivity and audio feeds from the ceremony. A platform for TV crews will be available at the back of the main ceremony tent. Photography and filming for all other purposes will be assured by the ceremony organisers with images and footage being made available immediately following the ceremony.
