

Guidelines for submission of proceedings

Proceedings for “*The 15th International Workshop on Tau Lepton Physics (Tau2018)*” are hosted on [SciPost.org](https://www.sci-post.org). The guide explains the necessary steps to submit your proceedings. Latex templates are attached to the indico agenda ([here](#)). Please use **only** these templates. 1.) Create an account

Before submitting your proceedings you need to create an account on [SciPost.org](https://www.sci-post.org). From the main page go to login (1) and then fill the registration form (2).

2.) Submit your manuscript

The submission is fairly easy. Once you created your account, sign in and go to the *Submissions* tab. Next click on *Submit an arXiv preprint to a SciPost journal*. arXiv is the preferred option, but you do not worry if your manuscript is not posted on arXiv as you can still choose a non-arXiv based submission on the following page.

Option **A**) If you submitted your proceedings to arXiv you only need to enter the identifier (without any prefix) including the version number and hit *Query arXiv*. The advantage of this option is that all required metadata is parsed from arXiv.

Option **B**) Alternatively, you can also upload you proceedings manually. For this follow *Submit manuscript without arXiv instead*. This will guide you to the same webform as option A, but you need to fill the metadata by yourself.

Abstract	<input type="text" value="The ATLAS experiment at the Large Hadron Collider (LHC) has been able to collect 5.25 fb<sup>-1</sup> of data in 2011. For many physics analyses both in context of the Standard Model (SM) and Beyond the Standard Model (BSM) theories such as Higgs boson searches, tau leptons play an important role. Thus, triggering on hadronic tau decays is an essential ingredient for the success of those measurements. This contribution will summarize the developed efforts to meet this challenge. Efficiency measurements using data taken in 2011 at a center-of-mass energy of 7 TeV are described and results are presented. An outlook on further developments of the tau trigger algorithms, to match future requirements and higher instantaneous luminosities are summarised in the end."/>
