# Fly to Moscow comfortable and directly

Moscow has direct flight connections with all major cities of the world (including Tokyo, Los Angeles and all European capitals).

Geneva-Moscow-Geneva is about 450 euros, 3.5 hours, 3 direct flights per day (Aeroflot - Russian International Airlines and Swiss Airlines)





# How to get from airports to Moscow

There are 3 international airports in Moscow: Sheremetyevo (SVO), Domodedovo (DME), Vnukovo (VKO).

All are connected to the Moscow metro system by express trains (Aeroexpress): about 40 minutes, 9 euro. Of course, taxi or car rent are also possible (but not advised to novices due to heavy Moscow traffic).

Moscow metro is one of the largest in the world (> 3 bln passengers per year) but easy to navigate, most of the information is doubled in English.

Operation hours: 05:45am - 1:00am, entrance payment (about 1 euro) valid for all the city (no pay zones).






# National University of Science and Technology MISiS

# **Campus location**


Campus NUST MISiS is conveniently located in the center of Moscow


