- There was an incident in November where a change to GGUS left Vos unable to submit alarm tickets.
- This raised two questions:-
- GGUS quality procedures. Can they convince users that they test changes enough to prevent a repeat?
- Out of hours support.
- GGUS actively working on these. A User Support Advisory Group meeting next week will discuss and I hope that GGUS can present the conclusions and progress to the January GDB

  - Consistent operational model
  - Fuller overview of Tier0/Tier1 networking for WLCG
  - Known Tier1-Tier1 links not in LHCOPN
    - NLT1-TRIUMF, NLT1-ASGC, FNAL-KIT, NLT1-FNAL
- Are there any new networking requirements, e.g. for improving Tier1-Tier2 connectivity?
  - If so, should LHCOPN community investigate this?
- Should we define SLA for links?
