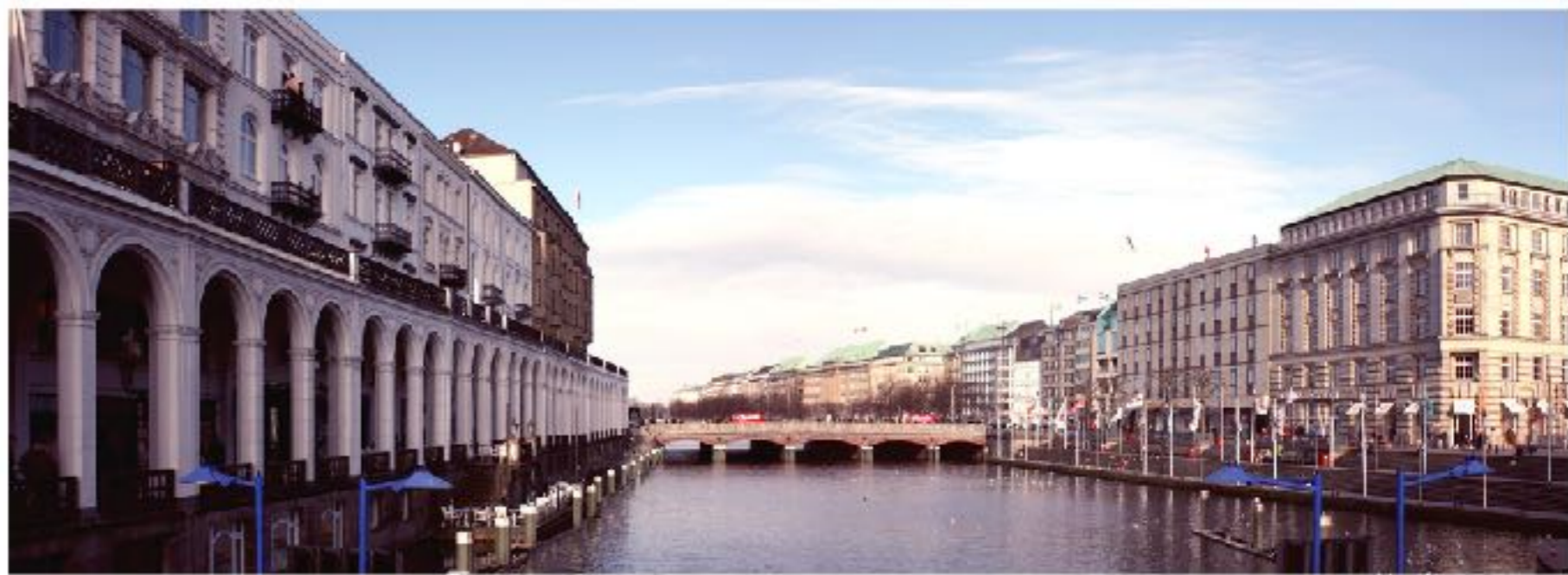




Hamburg

Hamburg Impressions

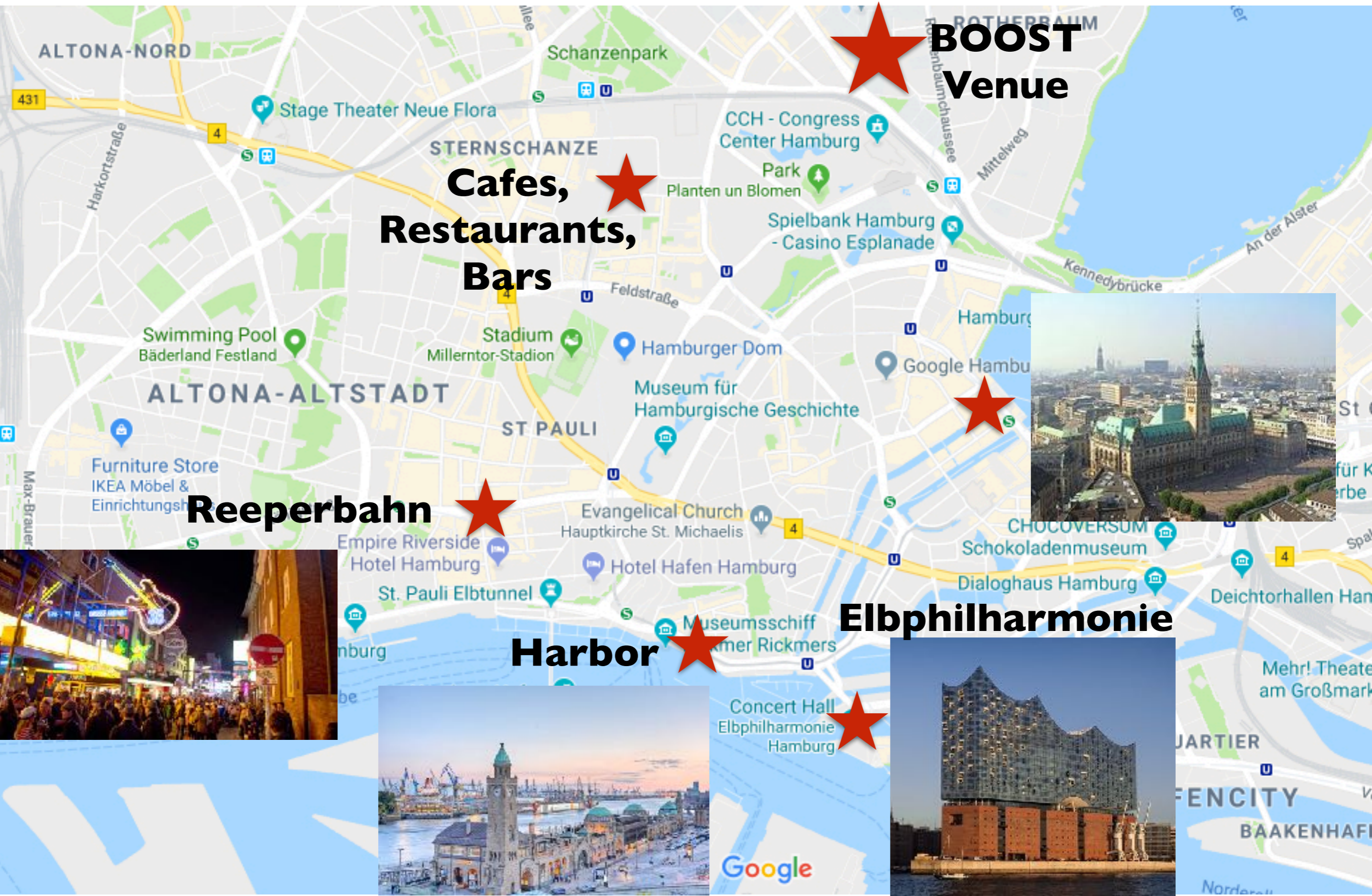


Venue

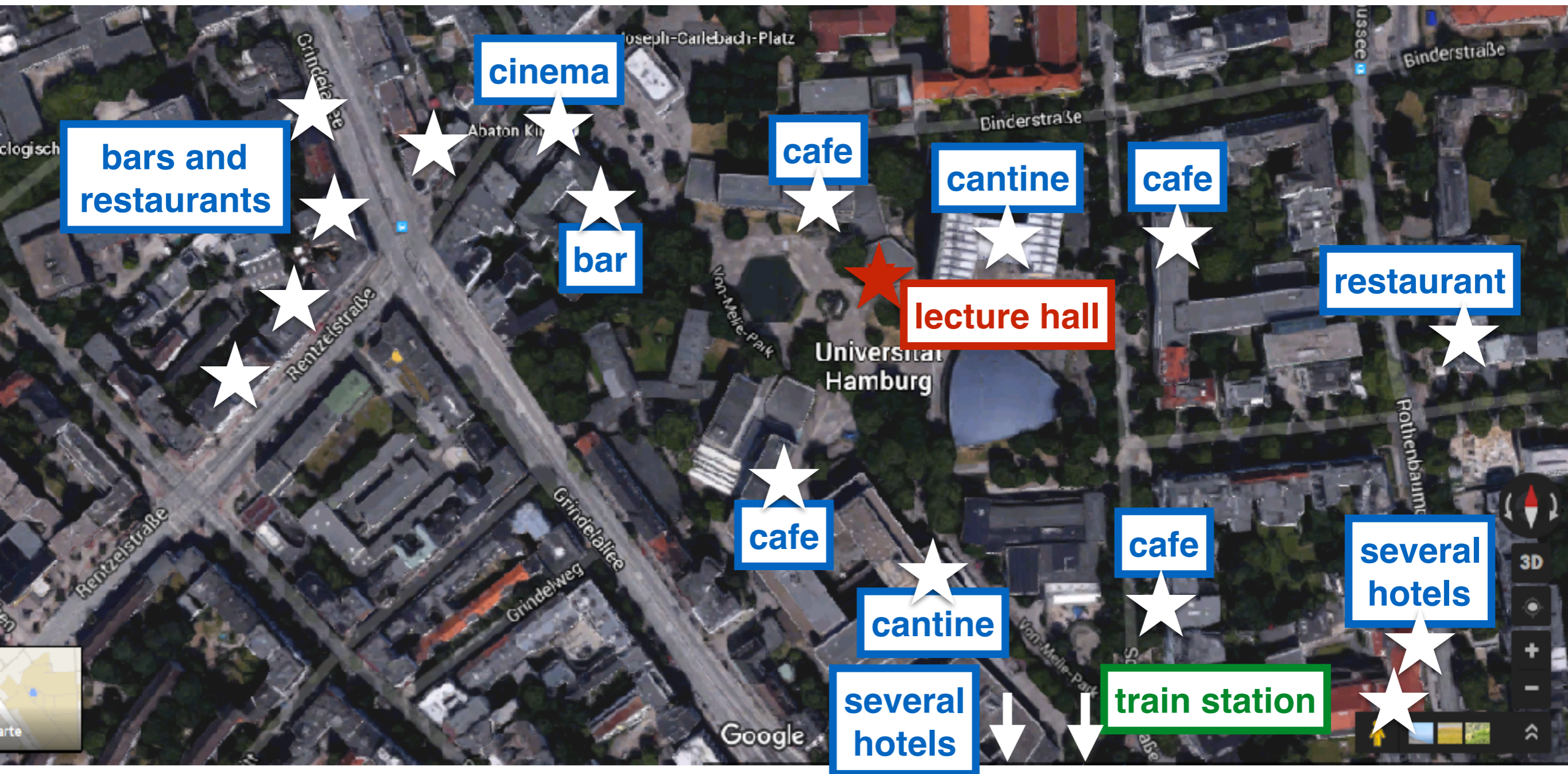

Transportation

- International Airport Hamburg (has direct flights to US)
- Airport is 20 min away from city center (trains every 10 min)
- Direct trains to Berlin and Munich every hour
- Excellent public transportation system

Accommodation

- HRS finds 150 accommodations (cheapest 29 EUR/night)
- 80 hotels within 2km distance from venue

Fee

- Workshop charge less than 250 EUR
- No charges for lecture hall, possibility for external funding
- University infrastructure (cantine, catering service etc.)

and warehouses)

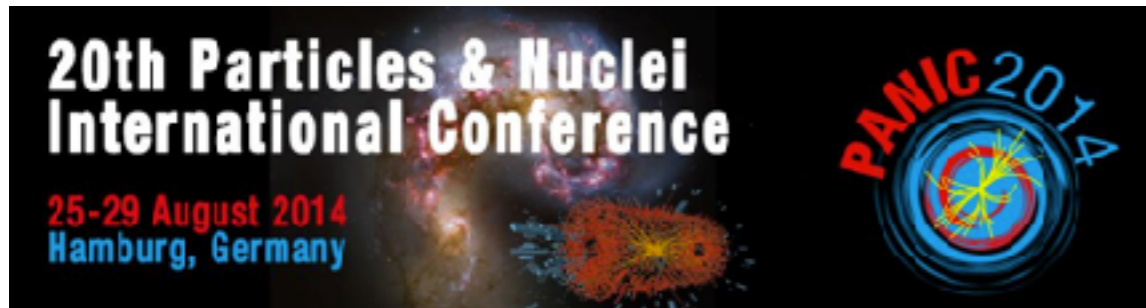


Possible Dinner Location
