

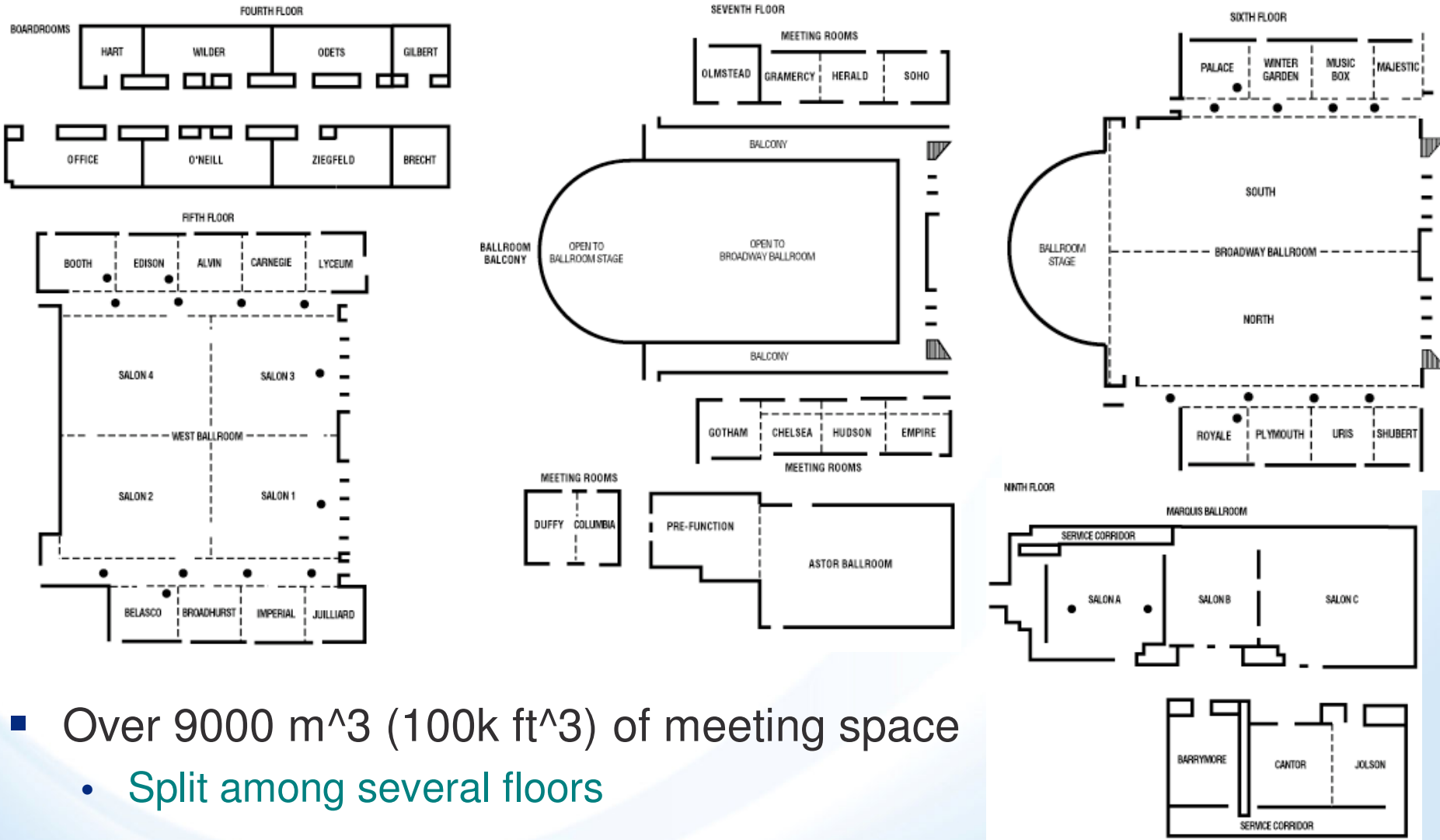

 - Split among several floors

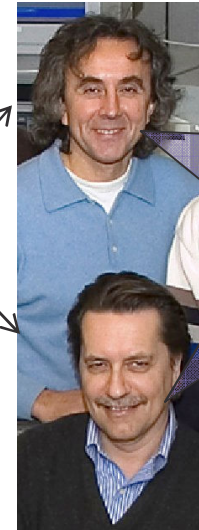

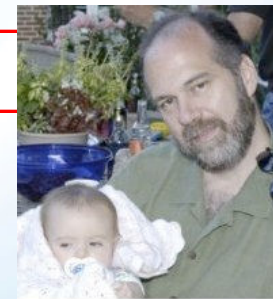
