- **Master/slave** and **parent/child** relationships are reset at closure time
 - **Hence it is not possible to search tickets profiting from the relationship**
 - Which were the slaves/children of this ticket
 - Which ticket was the master/parent of this ticket?
 - Was this ticket a master/parent at all?
- **if one clicks on the associated slaves of a master one gets an empty list.**
- **If an update is done on a closed ticket, or the ticket is reopened, it is not propagated to the related ticket.**

The problem is what to do when a ticket is reopened or an update is made

- if a **master** is reopened, shall **all** its **slaves** be reopened?
- if a **slave** is reopened, shall its **master** be reopened?
- if a **parent** is reopened, shall **all** its **children** be reopened?
- if a **child** is reopened, shall its **parent** be reopened?
