- Switch from using svn:externals to a copy
- Store QWG rev no. (not history)
- Previously had lots of exceptions in gridireland
- Encourages changes to be checked in to QWG

- quattor fetch
- quattor configure --all
- quattor configure filecopy
- quattor list
- quattor query ——component spma
- quattor query ——dump /system
  (only one known user!)


#### New Services

#### Replicating VM Hosts

**Enabling Grids for E-sciencE** 



- DRBD under LVM and Xen provides simple and effective redundancy
- Replicating whole storage is straightforward
  - No need to individually replicate VMs' storage
  - But means "all or none" failover for VMs
