What needs to be migrated



- CDB master and slave: on PPD
- Reco-Mover: on PPD (see Henry's talk)
- Archiver data
 - Live on PPD (heplnv154)
 - Final tarball on GRID
- MICENet backups and /Data area: on the GRID
- EPICS repository: part on launchpad, part on the GRID
- Scripts, documents, calibrations, code not pushed, random files save locally on machines not in backed-up areas: LOST!
