Keynote Talk

Dr Sébastien Ducourtieux is Research Engineer in Nano-metrology, working at the French National Metrology and testing Laboratory (LNE). Since 2001, he developed a series of characterization instruments with state of the art performances, with applications ranging from micro-electronics to Atomic Force Microscopy (AFM).

His talk will cover the general methodology for the integration of interferometers as position sensors when developing high precision instruments. The talk will be illustrated by a number of actual results and lessons learned from recent experiences.

A special emphasis will be placed on metrology aspects, practical and systematic approach to error sources separation and estimation, including their relations with environment control.
