Your Chianti:

Chianti Montalbano is a D.O.C.G. wine produced in Tuscany, in the center of Italy. Controlled and Guaranteed Designation of Origin is a seal of excellence for wine producers who follow strict production regulations and belong to a specific terroir. CAEN has always been proud of its Italian origin and in particular of the wonders Tuscany can offer, among which Chianti is a Worldwide known wine present in most restaurants scattered around the Globe, as such CAEN believed it would be the perfect present for an international conference as symbol of Italian excellence.

The Chianti Montalbano is a blend of Sangiovese, Canaiolo and Colorino grapes, which are natives of the Tuscany region and which grow on the hills between Florence and Prato, it has a wonderful red ruby color, it has harmonic and pleasant flavor yet it gives a persistent tannin in the mouth. It pairs well with the typical Italian semi-seasoned cheeses, first course with tasty meat sauces and grilled meat; it has a 13.5% alcohol content and the service temperature is 18° C.
