Guidelines for rotation of regions for LHCP conferences

The guidelines for rotation of the regions for the future LHCP conferences, accepted by LHCP IAC, beginning in 2016. The recommended cycle for rotation of the regions is 4 years, with European sites recommended every second year (given the size of the LHC community in Europe), and Asia/Pacific or Americas recommended in alternative years.

More specifically, the recommended 4-year cycle for the sites of the few past (beginning 2016) and future LHCP conferences is:

2016 Europe. -→ Lund, Sweden

2017 Asia/Pacific → Shanghai, China

2018 Europe → Bologna, Italy

2019 Americas or → Puebla, Mexico (selected in 2017)

then repeat the cycle of regions rotation:

2020 Europe (selected at this meeting, June 7, 2018)

Selection of the site for LHCP-2020

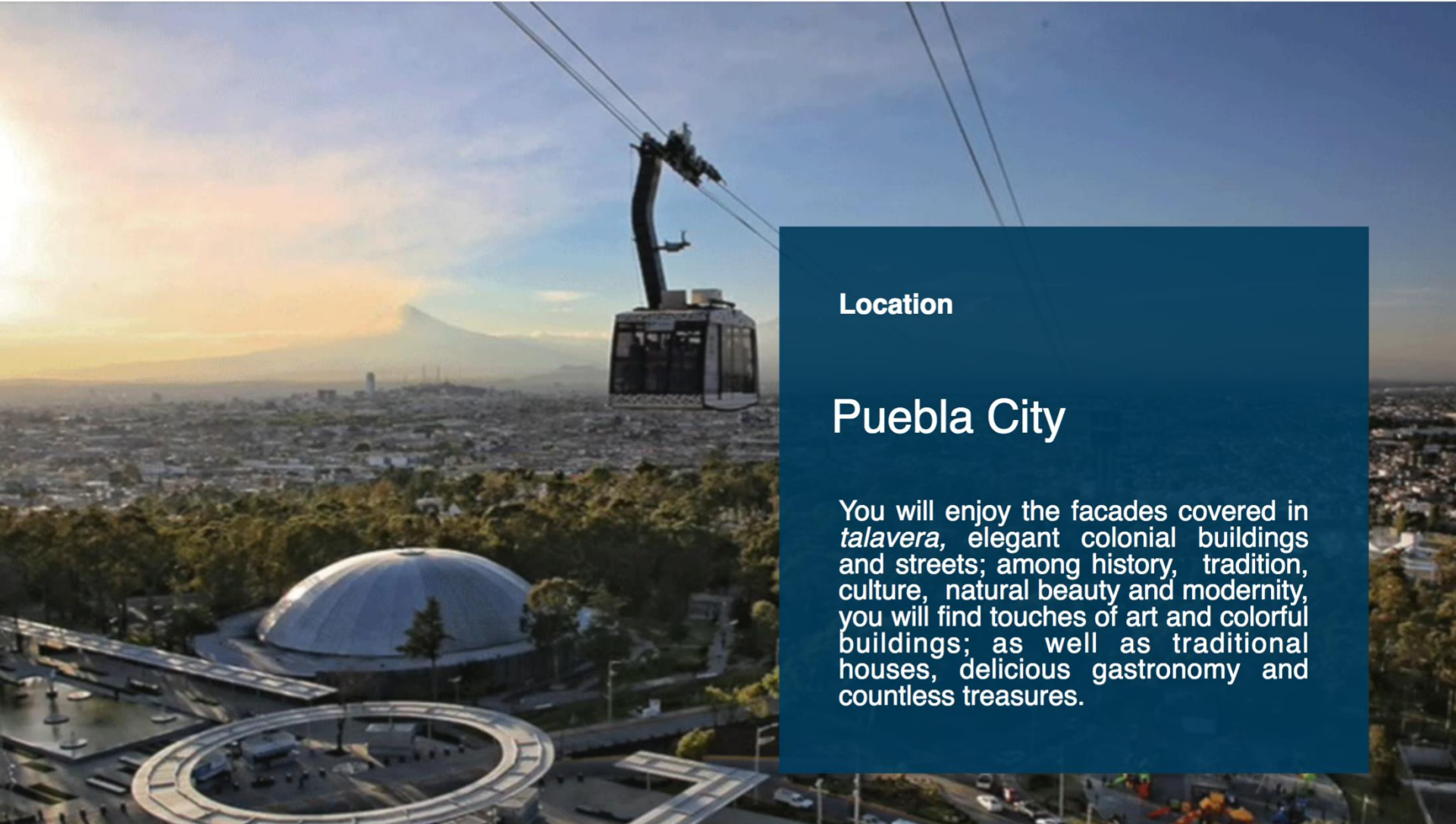

After deliberations, with positive arguments brought in favor of each of the proposals, the consensus recommendation by the IAC is to select **Paris, France**, as the site for the LHCP-2020. IAC wish to thank the speakers and proposal authors.
