## OVERVIEW OF PROTOCOLS CONCLUDED SINCE NOVEMBER 2016

At its Session on 21 June 2002, the Council approved a proposal for an approval procedure applicable to the conclusion of International Cooperation Agreements with non-Member States.

This procedure stipulates *inter alia* that the Council must be informed of Protocols (which are subsidiary Agreements through which International Cooperation Agreements are implemented) concluded in the course of the reporting period.

Such information was last given in document CERN/3284/RA at the December 2016 Council Session (covering the period from 28 November 2015 until 16 November 2016), and is now again provided to the Council, this time covering the period from 17 November 2016 until 20 November 2017.

### **Protocol P132 to the Cooperation Agreement dated 13 September 2006 between the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) and O Conselho Nacional De Desenvolvimento Científico E Tecnológico Do Brasil (CNPq)**

***Concluded:*** 19 January 2017.

***Title:*** Participation by Scientific Institutes and Universities from Brazil in the High-Energy Particle Physics Experiments at CERN.

***Duration:*** Currently until 12 September 2021.

***Subject:*** Operational framework for the participation by scientific and technical personnel of scientific institutes and universities from Brazil in high-energy particle physics experiments at CERN.

**Protocol P135 to the 2006 Cooperation Agreement between the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) and O Conselho Nacional De Desenvolvimento Cientifico E Tecnológico Do Brasil (CNPq)**

**Concluded:** 17 February 2017.

**Title:** Collaboration on R&D Activities in respect of the Glance/Fence Database and other research projects of common interest.

**Duration:** Currently until 12 September 2021.

**Subject:** Operational framework for collaboration between the parties in R&D activities concerning the Glance/Fence database and other research projects of common interest.

**Protocol P137 to the 1993 Cooperation Agreement between the European Organization for Nuclear Research (CERN) and the Government of the Russian Federation**

**Concluded:** 21 March 2017.

**Title:** Scientific collaboration between CERN and Tomsk Polytechnic University (TPU).

**Duration:** Currently until 29 October 2020.

**Subject:** Promotion and support of scientific and technical cooperation in fundamental research in high-energy physics and related fields of science.
