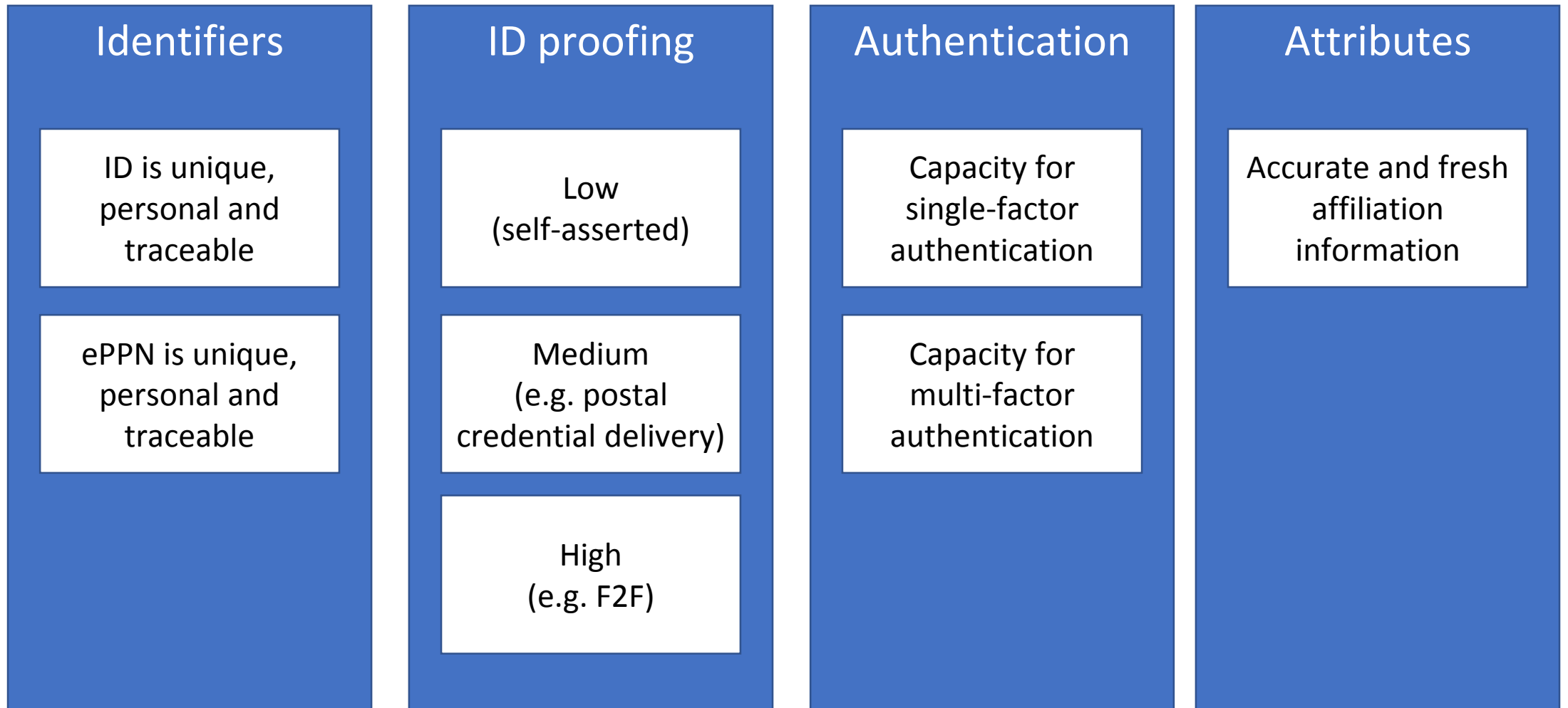

Short history and future

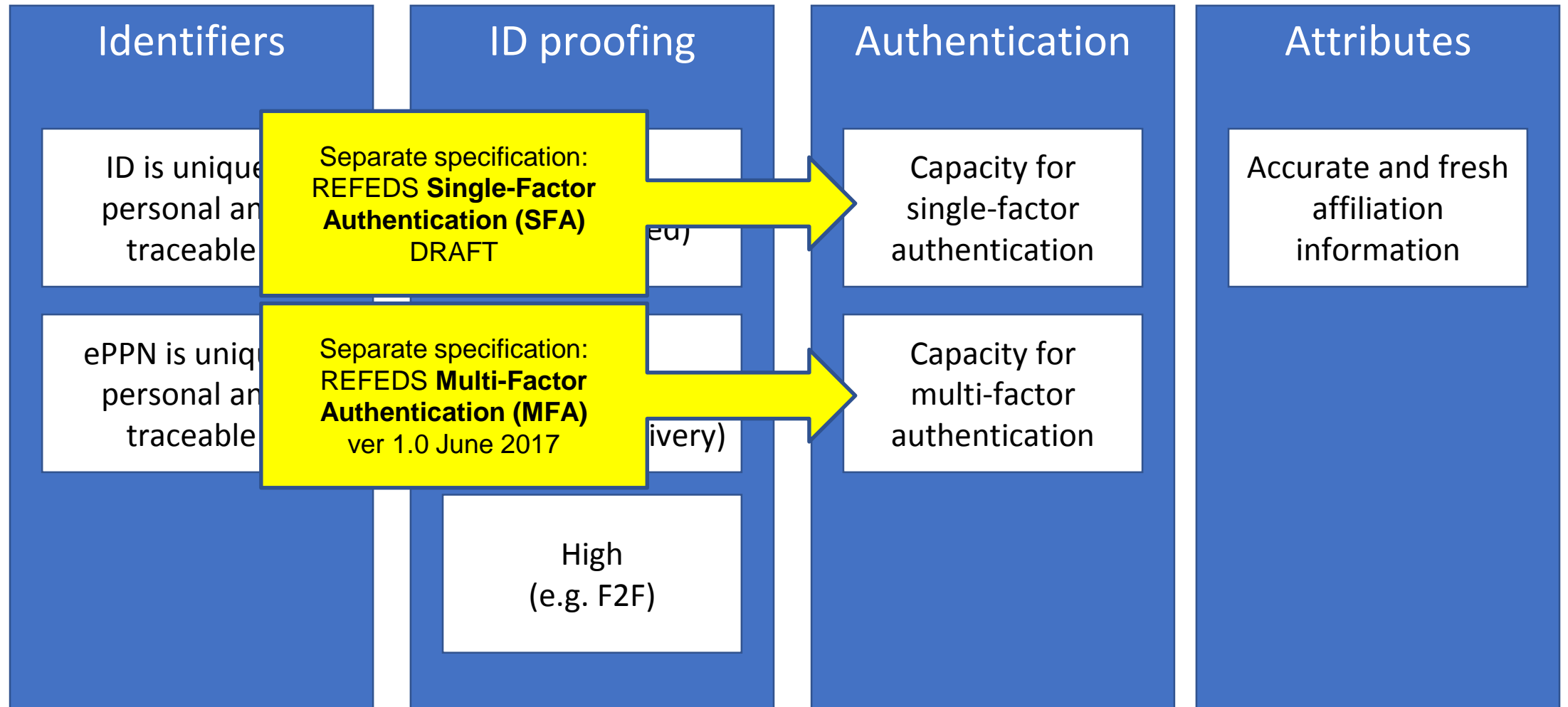
- 11/2015 AARC publishes minimal LoA requirements for low-risk research
- 6/2016 REFEDS establishes the Assurance working group
 - To write a specification to meet the requirements
- 4-6/2017 Public consultation on the 1st draft of the REFEDS Assurance Framework (RAF)

- Going to expose RAF to second public consultation soon
 - Together with REFEDS Single-Factor Authentication (SFA) profile
- Have a pilot on it
 - ELIXIR, BBMRI, EGI Check-in, CILogon

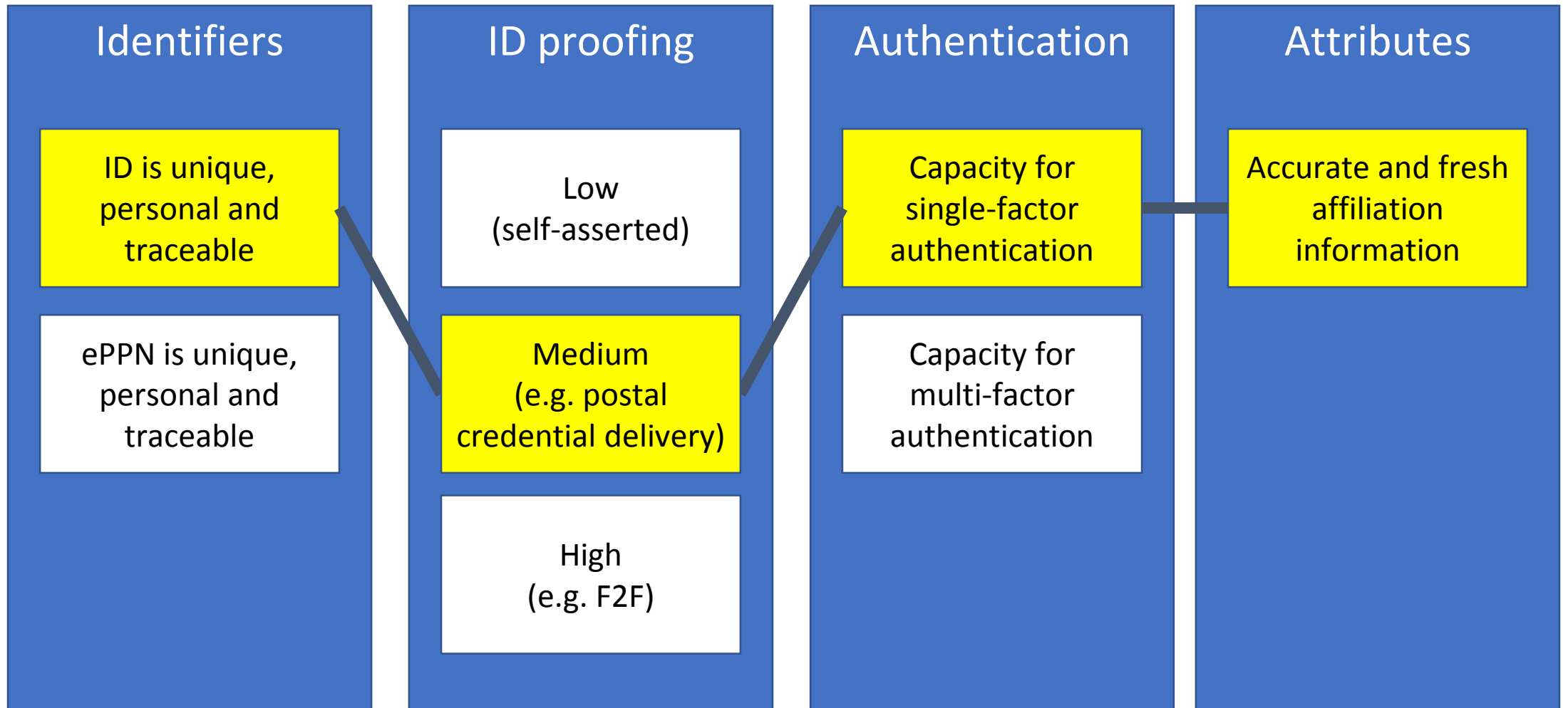
REFEDS assurance fw: four dimensions of LoA



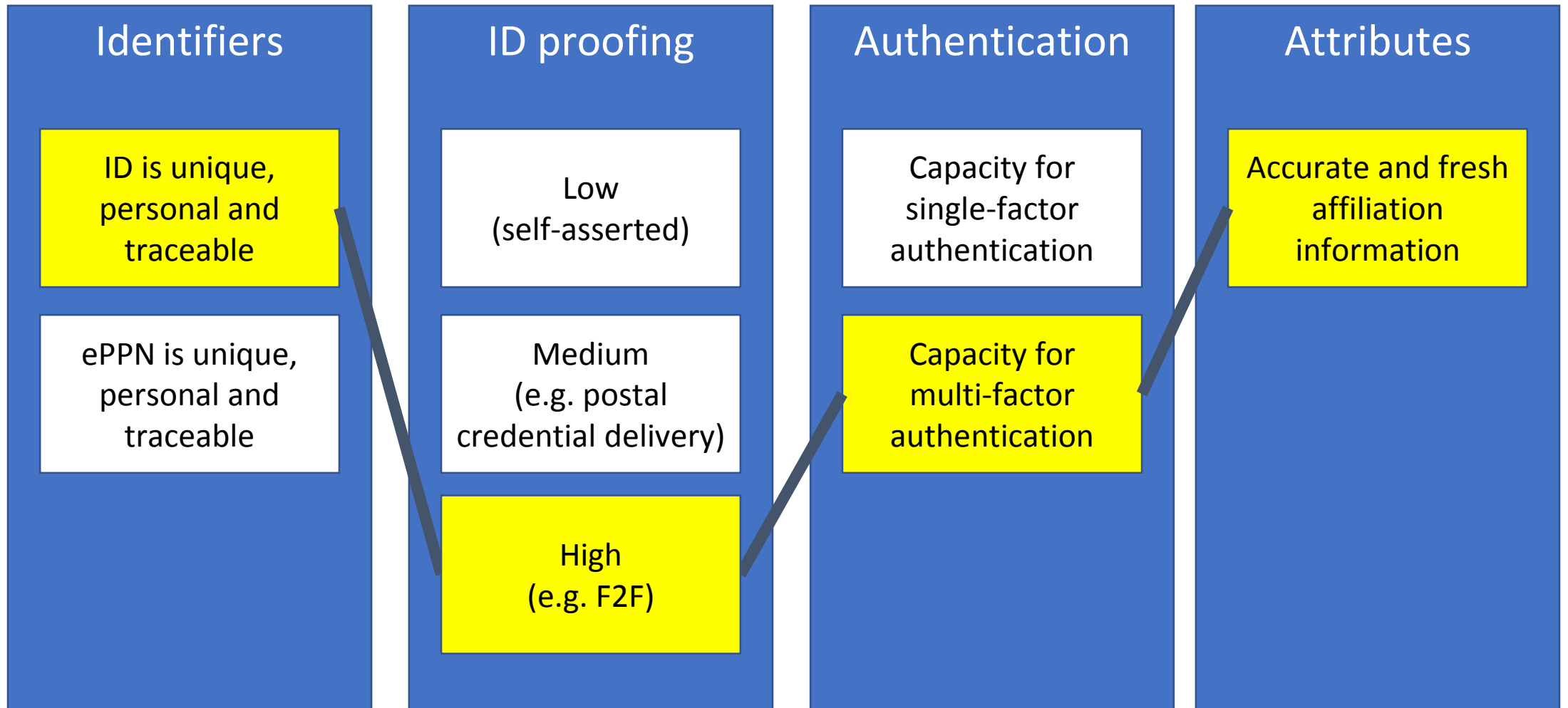
REFEDS assurance fw: four dimensions of LoA



“Cappuccino” profile for low risk use cases (c.f. AARC1 MNA3.1 “minimal requirements”)



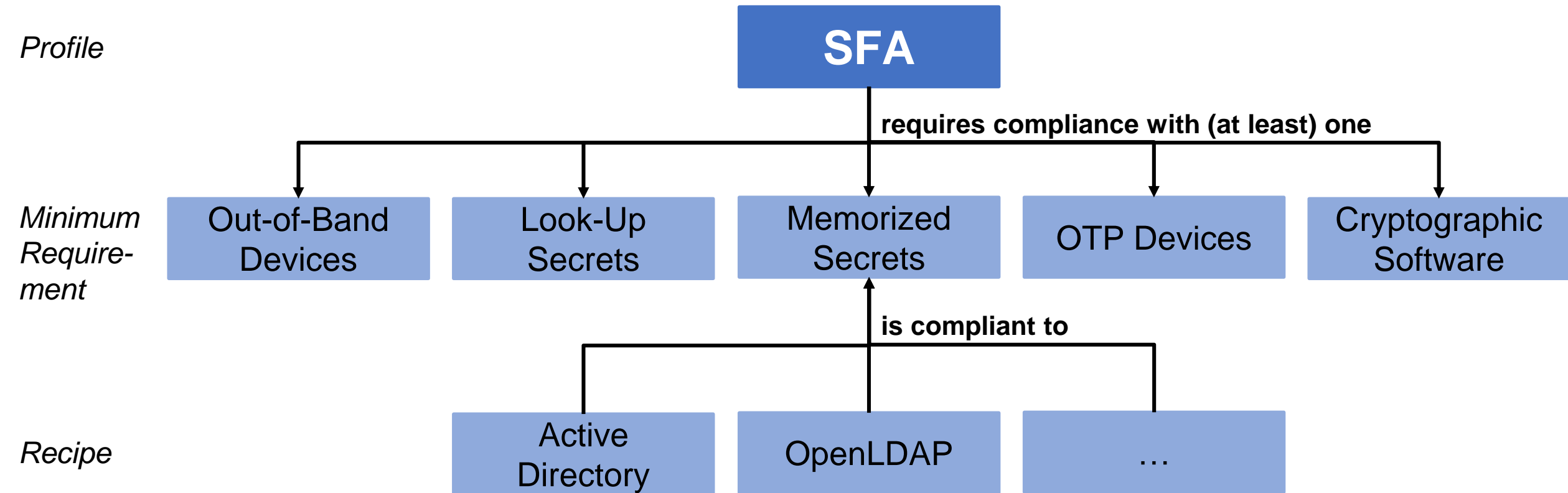
“Espresso” profile for demanding use cases



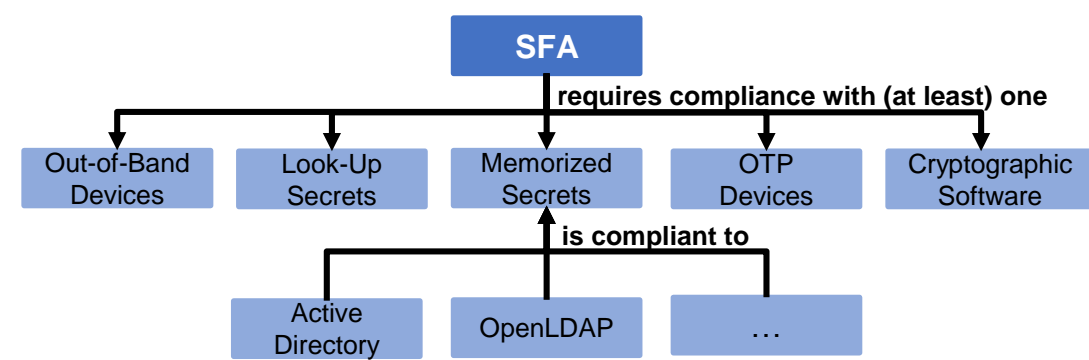

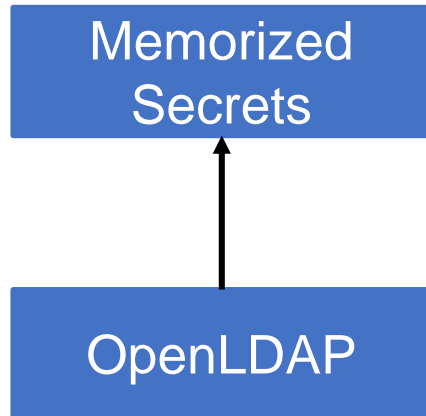
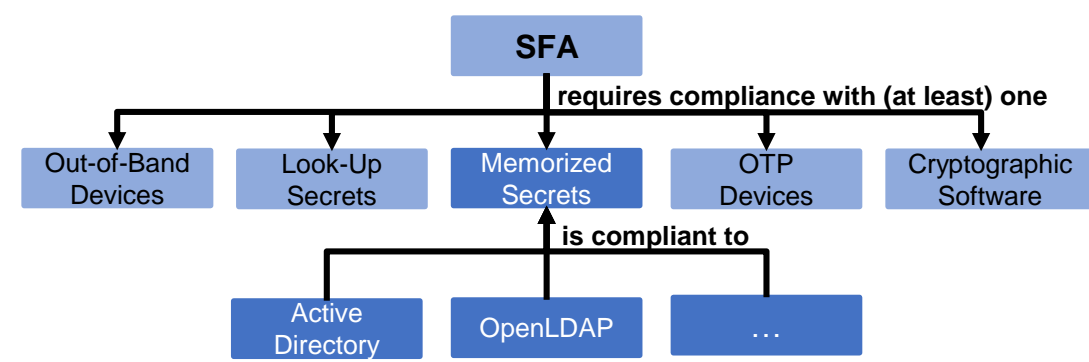
REFEDS Single-Factor Authentication Profile

- Criteria for authentication factor(s)
- Criteria for procedures to bypass an authentication factor

REFEDS SFA Minimum Requirements and Recipes



- Risk-based approach
- Defines a set of controls to mitigate risks
- Recipes provide implementation guidance for a specific technology
